Seasonal wildland fire dispatcher's duties primarily involve dispatching resources and managing communications during wildfire incidents. This includes receiving reports, coordinating responses, and documenting incidents. They also maintain communications using various systems, manage resource allocation, and track personnel and equipment.

## **Core Responsibilities:**

- **Dispatching Resources:** Dispatching personnel, equipment, and supplies to wildfire incidents.
- Communication Management: Operating radio systems, phone lines, and other communication equipment to maintain contact with field personnel and the public.
- Incident Coordination: Coordinating with Incident Command and other dispatch centers to ensure effective resource deployment.
- Documentation: Maintaining detailed records of dispatch activities, communications, and incident details using WildCAD and IROC
- Resource Tracking: Tracking the status of resources (personnel, equipment, etc.) during mobilization and demobilization.
- Mapping and Location: Using maps and GIS/GPS systems to locate and track fire incidents.
- Weather Information: Monitoring and broadcasting weather updates and forecasts.

## JOB REQUIREMENTS/SKILLS:

High school diplomas or equivalent required. Related experience as a wildland firefighter or emergency dispatcher is preferred or prior NWCG certified training in this field.

Incumbent is required to exceed a 40-hour workweek when emergency situation warrants and/or be available for on-call status. Eligible for overtime pay on fires.
