## FIRE RESTRICTIONS

Fire risk is elevated in Grand Teton National Park due to very dry conditions.

*Please partner with us to prevent fires by complying with the following fire restrictions:*

1. Campfires are **ONLY ALLOWED** within an established **METAL** fire ring at developed campgrounds and recreation areas;
  - Douse your campfire with water, stir, add more water and stir again.
  - Make sure your campfire is COLD to the touch before leaving it.
2. Fires in charcoal or wood-fired grills provided in developed recreation sites **ARE ALLOWED**;
  - Properly dispose of coals by soaking them in water until they are COLD to the touch
  - Place cold coals in trash or pack them out.

3. Gas fired stoves and grills **ARE allowed**.
4. Smoking is **ONLY PERMITTED** within an enclosed vehicle, a developed campground site or in an area that is clear of all flammable materials for minimum of three feet in all directions.
