Crawl low under smoke!

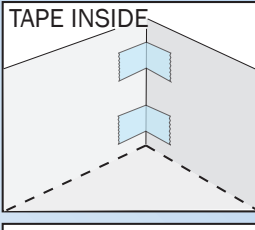
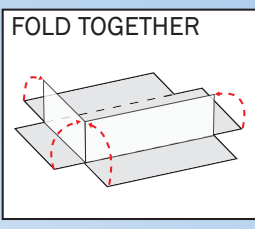
When the smoke alarm sounds, get out and stay out!

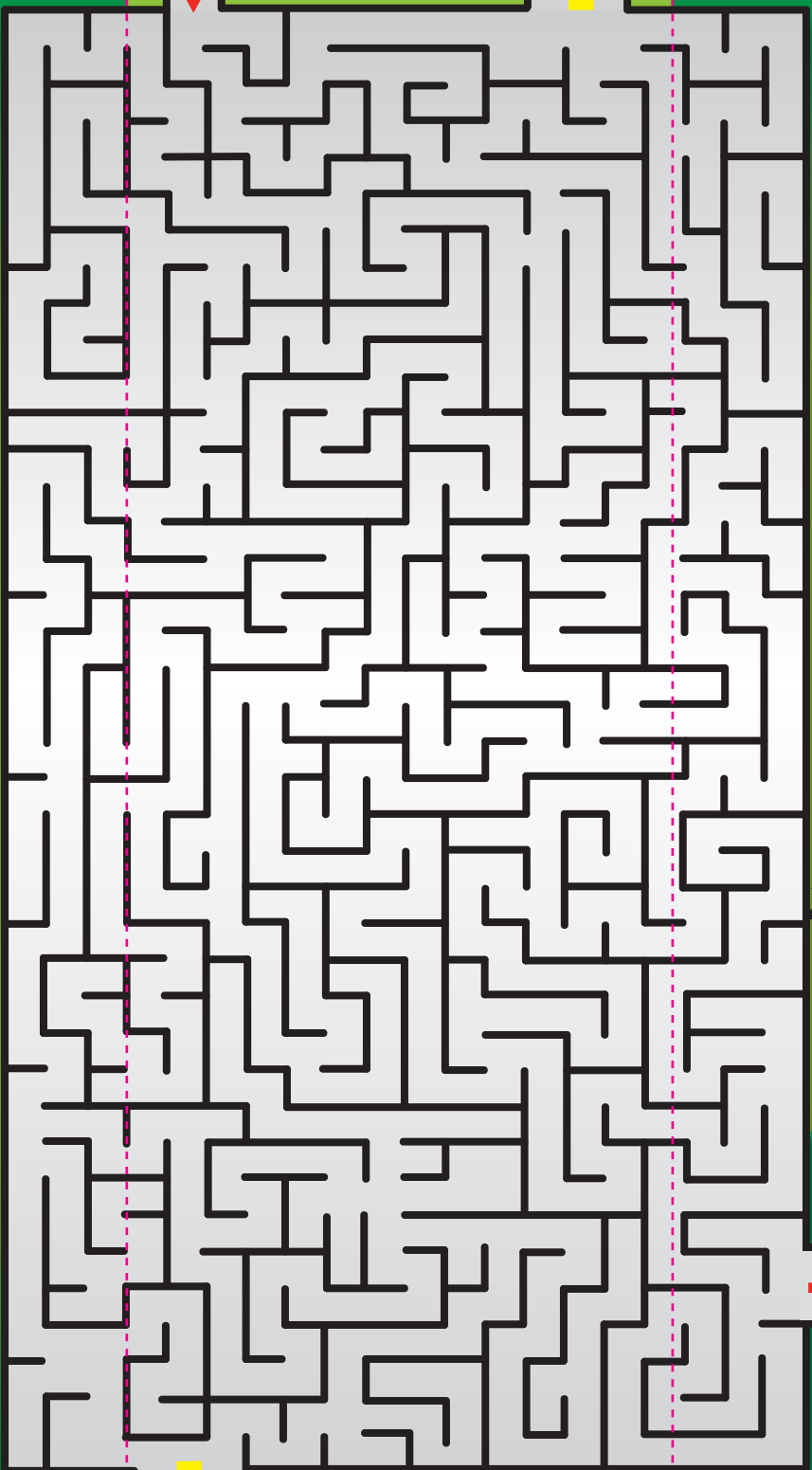
