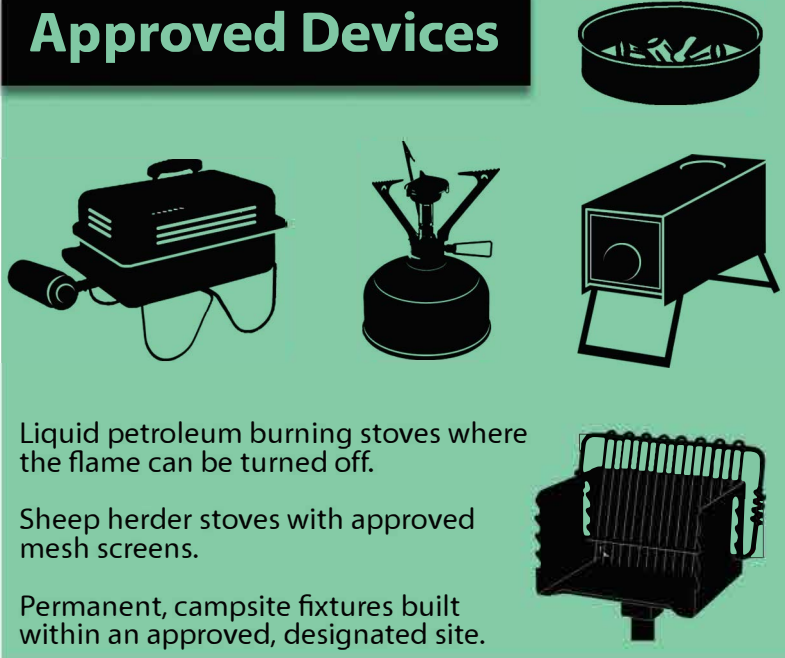

Permanent, campsite fixtures built within an approved, designated site.

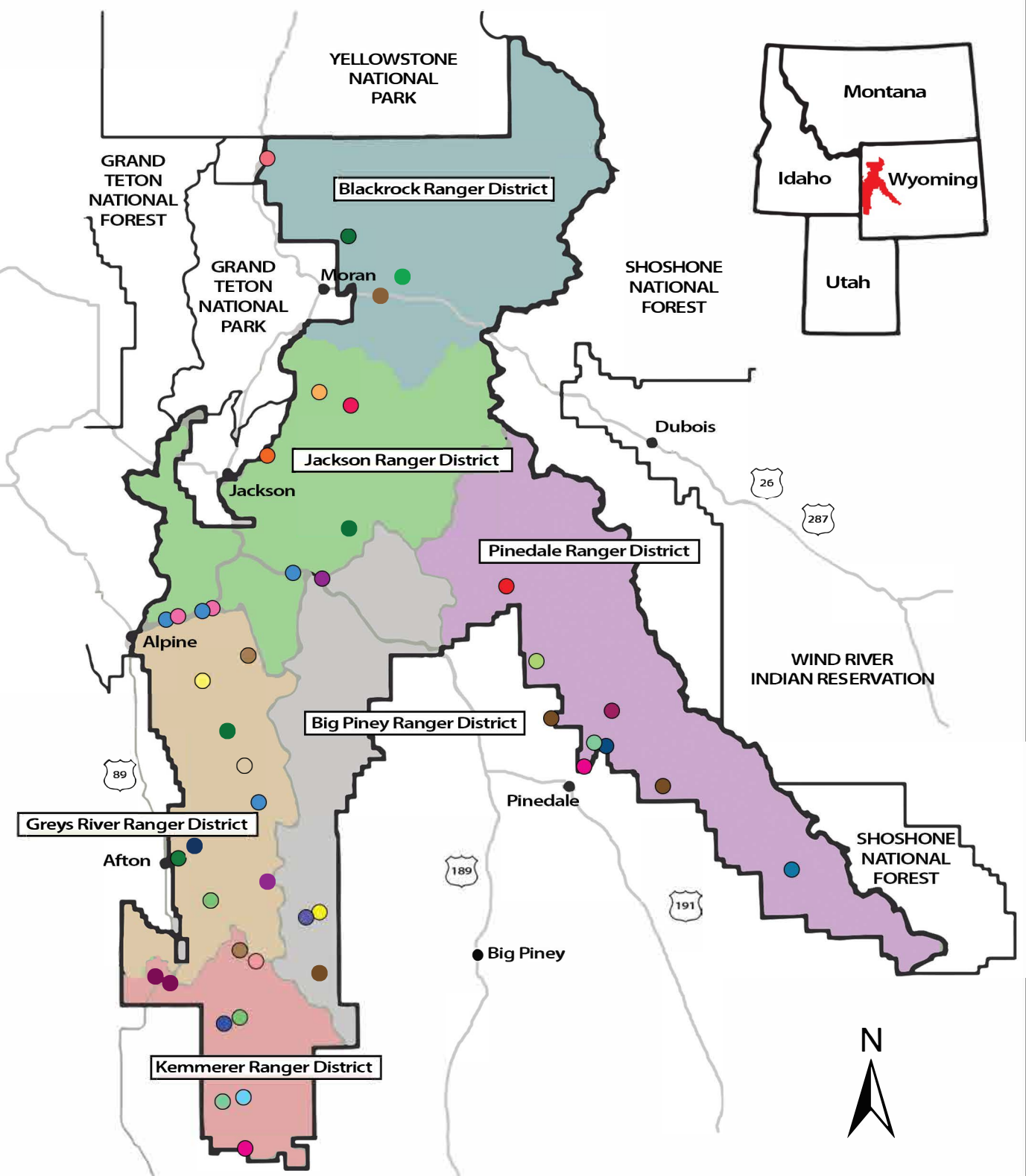
Devices Not Allowed
