

Sheep Mountain Fire



Location : Sheep Mountain, between Flat Creek and the Gros Ventre drainage.

Fuels: The fire started from a lightning strike to a single tree, in an open meadow along the west aspect of Sheep Mountain.

Closures: No closures at this time. The fire is ½ mile south of the hiking trail. Smoke is visible.

Teton Interagency Fire engages wildfires in ways that reduce risk to firefighter and public safety, property, infrastructure and valuable natural and cultural resources. When conditions are right, the agencies may manage all or part of lightning caused fires to reduce hazardous fuels, improve habitat and achieve other natural resource management objectives consistent with Land Management Plan direction. Fire plays a beneficial role in maintaining the ecological stability of many landscapes and the Forest Service is working with partners to restore healthy, resilient and fire-adapted ecosystems.
