(C)	All motorized vehicles prohibited yearlong except over-snow machines operating on snow.	Backcountry, unroaded area. Special permit area.
(D)	All motorized vehicles and public use including snowmobile, foot, ski, and snowmachine travel prohibited November 15 - April 30, except on identified routes.	Prevent unnecessary stress to wildlife during winter months.

DEFINITIONS

IDENTIFIED ROUTE - Where travel is limited to a specific road or trail and the area adjacent to the route is closed. For specific drives and modes of transportation on specific identified routes, refer to the map on this map. Forest users should be aware that some identified routes may be impossible due to seasonal changes. You are advised to contact the local Ranger District office for information on current route conditions.

OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE (OHV) - Any motorized vehicle which is less than 45' in width and is designed for cross-country travel on or immediately over land, water, snow, sand, ice, marsh, swampland, or other terrain. This would include, but is not limited to, such vehicles as four-wheel-drive, motorcycles, snowmobiles, amphibians, and air cushion vehicles.

OVER-SNOW VEHICLE - A self-propelled vehicle designed for travel on snow, having a curb weight of not more than 1,000 pounds, driven by a track or tracks in contact with the snow, and steered by a ski or skis.
