Pole Creek Fire Emergency Road Closure

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b) the following acts are prohibited in the area, roads, and trails as described in this order, all within the **Kemmerer Ranger District**, Bridger-Teton National Forest until further notice:

1. Using a motor vehicle on any road described below. 36 CFR 261.54(a)

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

ROADS DESCRIBED:

FSR 10154(East Fork Road) and FSR 10155(Beaver Creek) beginning at the Bridger-Teton National Forest boundary.

The above described area is within the proclaimed and administrative boundaries of the Kemmerer Ranger District in the Bridger-Teton National Forest in Lincoln County, Wyoming.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this order is to provide for public safety from current fire activities and minimize travel conflicts for fire resources associated with the Pole Creek Fire.

IMPLEMENTATION:

- 1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until September 30th, 2017, or rescinded, whichever occurs first.
- 2. A map identifying the closed roads is attached and made part of this Order.
- Any violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for individuals, and \$10,000.00 for organizations and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
- 4. This Order supersedes any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order.
