Dollar Lake Fire Area, Road and Trail Closure

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following are prohibited on the National Forest System (NFS) lands, roads, trails in the Pinedale Ranger District, Bridger-Teton National Forest, described below and shown on the attached map incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A (the “DESCRIBED AREA, ROADS and TRAILS”):

1. Entering of being in the Described Area. 36 C.F.R. § 261.52(e).
2. Being on the Described Trails. 36 C.F.R. § 261.55(a).
3. Being on the Described Roads. 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e).

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order or a written determination by a Forest Service authorized officer that a permit is not required under 36 C.F.R. § 251.50(e)(1) or (2).
2. Any Federal, State, or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

DESCRIBED AREA, ROADS and TRAILS

The described area is the area within the fire perimeter, identified on the ground as burned area edge, is closed. The area south and east of the Green River Lakes Road (FS650), as mapped fire perimeter on September 29, 2025, and all roads and trails within that area are closed. The Moose-Gypsum road (FS680) network is open where it is outside the fire perimeter. Portions of the Middle Gypsum (FS684), Main and South Gypsum (FS683) road systems are closed. The Green River Lakes Road remains open even where it overlaps with the fire perimeter. The boat ramp and Green River Lake are open to use. Green River Lake Campground and Lodge remain closed.

Described Roads Closed within the Moose-Gypsum Road (680) Network:

Portions of the 680 road and all of 680G and 680H
Upper extent of 683 and all of the 683F
Upper extents of 684 and 684A and all of 684C, 684D, 684E and 684F
Upper extents of 689 and all of 689B
Upper extend of 683D

Described Roads Closed within the Green River Lake Road Network:

Portions of 658 and 658A

Described Trails Closed:

Portions of the New Fork/Porcupine Trail (7137)
All of the Shirley Lake Trail (7083) and the Shoreline Trail (7144)

All as depicted in Exhibit A.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Order is to for public and firefighter health and safety during the Dollar Lake Fire.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order shall be in effect from October 01 at 0400 AM through November 15 at 0400 AM, unless rescinded.
2. A map identifying the closure area and affected roads and trails is attached and made part of this Order as Exhibit A. For a digital version of this Order and Exhibit A, go to <https://www.fs.usda.gov/alerts/ /alerts-notices>.
3. Unless otherwise expressly defined in this Order, the terms used in this Order are defined by the regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture, 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299. If there are terms in this Order that are not expressly defined in the Order or 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299, their meaning shall be determined by their plain language definitions.
4. A violation of the above prohibitions is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.
