## Allred Flat Campground Fuels Project

**Scheduled:** April 30<sup>th</sup> to May 27<sup>th</sup>  
**Location:** Allred Flat CG, Kemmerer RD  
**Unit Area:** Approximately 13 acres  
**Fuel Type:** Live, Standing Dead & Dying,  
Overhead Hazards

### Objectives:

- The purpose is to reduce fire threat and provide a service which will create a safe experience to forest campers and visitors. This will be accomplished by the reduction of live fuels and removal of standing dead and dying trees. Resulting in lower fire danger and reduction of overhead hazards.

### Cooperators:

- This project is a cooperative project supported by the Bridger-Teton National Forest.



### Project Details:

The Bridger-Teton West Zone Fire and Fuels modules, along with Kemmerer R.D. recreation program will be implementing a thinning/ maintenance project between April 30<sup>th</sup> to May 27<sup>th</sup>, 2021.
