

Dollar Lake Fire Incident Update

There will be a community meeting tomorrow, September 3, from 6 to 7 p.m. at The Place Bar and Grill located at 2000 N. Highway 352, Cora, Wyo.

FIRE ACTIVITY:

The Dollar Lake Fire is currently at 15,282 acres and 25% containment.

Yesterday, fire crews completed successful, strategic firing operations on the southeastern end of the fire. This tactic was used to remove heavy dead-and-downed trees and snags, furthering protection around the Bible Camp and Kendall Valley communities while reducing risk to firefighters. Today, crews on the west side of the fire continue to mop up and patrol to ensure the fire remains within established control features, as well as work with resource advisors on plans for suppression repair. On the northernmost end of the fire east to Green River Lakes Campground, firefighters are mopping up and reinforcing existing control features, if needed. Firefighters on the eastern interior of the fire will scout for routes to construct indirect line from Little Sheep Mountain to the southeast. Crews continue to construct and improve direct line between Little Sheep Mountain and the Bible Camp area. The structure protection group continues to bolster defense systems around the Bible Camp area and improve defensible space. The structure group will also assist with initial attack of new starts within the Dollar Lake Fire area.

Note that fire activity may increase as weather continues to become warmer and drier.

WEATHER:

Warm and dry conditions will continue as high pressure persists to our southwest. There will be an increased chance for some mostly dry (virga) showers this afternoon, which may bring gusty outflow winds. Winds today are expected to be generally gustier than previous days. Similarly warm and dry conditions are expected Wednesday.

EVACUATIONS:

Go (Evacuation Order) Status - No change

A five-mile radius around Dollar Lake in the Green River Lakes area.

The Red Cliff Bible Camp area in Cora, WY.

Set (Be Prepared to Evacuate) Status - No change

All residences in Moose Gypsum Road, Hill Road, Valley View Trail, Hecox Road, Pine Drive; Rock Creek Road, Brookie Lane, White Point Road, Rainbow Drive, Trout Drive, Cutthroat Drive, and River Road; Cattle Drive Lane, Terrace Drive, Half-Way Drive; all residences off Galley Lane; and all residences along US Hwy 352 South to Richard Lane.

Ready (Monitor) Status - No change

Areas south of Richard Lane.

CLOSURES:

The Bridger-Teton National Forest has issued a closure order for the Dollar Lake Fire area. Effective immediately, the closure area encompasses the Forest east and south of Green River above its junction with Union Pass Road (FS600). Where the Green River exits Green River Lake, the lake shore becomes the boundary along to the south where it meets the Bridger Wilderness boundary. From there it follows the Wilderness boundary south to the South Fork of Gypsum Creek. Then it follows the South Fork of Gypsum Creek southwest to Hwy 352 where the pavement turns to dirt road (Forest Boundary). The area east of the road (FS600 is closed) north up to the Green River Lakes Road at its junction with Union Pass Road.

Gypsum Creek Road from the Forest boundary north and the network of roads branching off it are in the closure area and not open to the public.

FIRE RESTRICTIONS:

Stage 1 Fire Restrictions are in effect for the Bridger-Teton National Forest. Fires are not permitted unless they are within a metal or concrete fire pit installed and maintained at a developed recreation site; liquid or gas fuel that can be turned off and no flammable materials within three feet; or a fully enclosed metal stove with a chimney and mesh screen spark arrestor.
