The Bridger-Teton National Forest is committed to developing and maintaining a highly skilled workforce for wildland fire operations and fuels management. The Teton Interagency Fire and Aviation program includes a variety of specialized positions including apprentice, engine crews, fuels management, wildland fire module, shorthaul helitack and prevention.

It is important that applicants understand, although a current position may not be vacant, it could become vacant and filled during the selection period. This is called the backfill process of fire hire. Interested individuals should apply to all positions and locations where they would be willing to accept a job offer, whether the position(s) are currently vacant or not.

For full consideration, please respond to the outreach. Your response is important. Please address your outreach response to the contact listed for each location. Additional information about the position is available from the direct supervisor. You may use the attached outreach response form.

All applicants must attach a current copy of their IQCS Master Record or equivalent to their USAJOBS application showing that they meet the Interagency Fire Program Management (IFPM) qualification requirements. Recommended documentation type is .PDF or .DOC. Please contact your servicing Dispatch Center or Training Officer to obtain a copy of this record and ensure that you have it attached to your USAJOBS application prior to submission. About The Bridger-Teton National Forest:

At 3,400,000 acres, the B-T is the third largest National Forest in the United States outside of Alaska. It lies in Western Wyoming, adjoining Yellowstone and Grand Teton National Parks and within the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem, the largest remaining area of undeveloped land in the 48 conterminous United States. It is noted for its unusual scenery and natural features, large and diverse wildlife populations, and habitat for threatened and endangered species. The Forest contains the headwaters of 4 major river basins: the Yellowstone (Missouri/Mississippi Basin); Snake (Columbia); Green (Colorado); and the Bear River (Great Basin). Seven major mountain ranges are found within the Forest Boundaries. These mountain ranges are part of the northern Rocky Mountains and include part of the striking Teton Range and Wind River Mountains. The Forest borders Jackson Hole, famous in the history of early explorers and fur traders, and winter home of the well-known Jackson elk herd. The Forest, with its Supervisor's Office in Jackson, is composed of the Jackson, Blackrock, Pinedale, Big Piney, Greys River, and Kemmerer Ranger Districts.

North Zone

- There are two fire/duty stations on the North Zone, Jackson and Moran (Blackrock Ranger District).
- The North Zone staffs one Type 4 engine out of Jackson and helps staff a interagency Type 3 engine out of Moose.
- Two Type 3 Helicopters are located on the Jackson RD with a 31 person helitack/shorthaul crew.
- The Blackrock RD hosts the Interagency Teton Fire Module.
- Housing may be available.

The Process and Timeline

August 22, 2025 – Announcements will be activated in USAJobs. Applicants are encouraged to apply for duty locations (where they would accept a position if offered), even if positions for certain locations which you are interested are not currently listed as vacant. Vacancies may occur during the hiring process and could be filled during Selection Week(s).

September 23, 2025-Vacancy announcements application deadline, 11:59 Eastern standard time. Apply through www.usajobs.gov. Applicants are encouraged to apply for multiple locations (where they would accept a position if offered), even if positions for certain locations in which you are interested are not listed as vacant. Vacancies may occur during the hiring process and could be filled during Selection Week(s).

October 27, 2025 – November 21, 2025 – Supervisory Reference Checks, Subject Matter Expert evaluations, and Interviews will occur these weeks. Please ensure your references are notified of this and they are available at the email address (preferred) or phone number provided on your application.

November 18, 2025 – November 20, 2025 – GS-09 Interviews will be conducted. Applicants that have applied for target grade GS-0462-09 positions should plan to be available for interviews from interested forests.

December 1, 2025 – December 17, 2025 – Selections. Representatives from each forest will make recommendations for hiring. Candidates selected will be notified by a Forest Service representative by phone. Those not selected should check your USAjobs account for status updates. It is highly encouraged to be available via phone during this time.

WORK CAPACITY TEST (WCT) for Wildland Firefighters: These positions participate in wildland firefighting activities. Based on the type of work performed, TAKING and PASSING the WCT at the ARDUOUS level is a "condition of employment." The Arduous fitness (Pack) test consists of a three (3) mile hike, within forty-five (45) minutes, while carrying a forty-five (45) pound pack. You are strongly encouraged to consult with your physician and begin training immediately if you are applying for this position. This announcement constitutes the required 30 days advanced notice for testing requirements.

September 23rd, 2025

Applications must be submitted before the September cutoff date to be considered.
