





***ERCs peaked across southwest Idaho and northwest Utah in early to mid-August.

Live Fuel Moisture:

Live fuel moistures were very low across southwest Idaho (top) all season with new records set. The values bottomed out in mid-August.




Across central Utah fuel moistures remained very high through mid-June before leveling out then rising during late July/August.



Preparedness Level Review

During 2013, the national Preparedness Level (PL) was elevated to PL 2 on June 3, then to PL 3 on June 21. On July 12 it was reduced back to PL 2 and remained there until July 22 when it was elevated back to PL 3. On August 9 the PL was raised to 4, where it remained until August 20 when it was elevated to PL 5. This was the first time, since 2007, to reach PL 5. On August 27 the PL was reduced to PL 4 where it remained until September 2 when it was reduced to PL 3. On September 5 the PL was reduced to PL 2 through September 23 when it dropped to PL 1 for the remainder of the year.


2013 National Preparedness Levels



Eastern Great Basin's preparedness level was elevated from 1 to 2 on June 13, where it remained until July 13. July 20 marked the date EGB reached PL 4 for the first time during the season. Eight days later it was lowered to a PL 3 on July 29th.


The next upward trend began on August 8th when the preparedness level was elevated to PL 4 followed immediately to a PL 5 on August 9th. It remained at a 5 for almost 2 weeks until it was lowered to PL 4 on August 23rd, PL 3 August 26th, and PL 2 September 7th. The Preparedness Level has remained at 1 since September 19th.

2013 Eastern Great Basin Preparedness Levels





Season Review

Eastern and Western Great Basin had a moderately above average year for fire occurrence and total acres for 2013. There were 2,935 fires reported, burning a combined total acres of 936,696.



EGB Comparison with Historical Averages



Eastern Great Basin was on par for the 5, 10 and 20 year average for fire starts as well as acreage burned.




Year End Totals by Cause

Fire statistics for this report were pulled from the SIT report. The statistics have not been reconciled with 1202s or FIRESTAT. Eastern Great Basin reported 2,214 fires for 767,954 acres. 773 of those starts were human caused while 1,441 were natural fires. Historically, 40% of all fires reported are human caused. For 2013, the human caused fires were slightly below that average at 34.9%.




Human Caused Fires by Agency




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
Lightning Caused Fires by Agency



Total Number of Fires by State





Total Number of Acres Burned by State

Large Fire Occurrence by Month


The first large fire of the year was the Hayden fire. The Hayden fire was human caused located 7 miles northeast of Ft. Duchesne, Utah. It started on March 30th and burned for 5 days with the final size reported as 365 acres.

The largest fire of the year was the Elk Complex comprised of the Village and Pierce fires for 131,258.0 acres. The lightning caused fires started on August 8th and 9th respectively and were contained on 8/31/2013. The fires were located 10 miles southwest of Pine, Idaho.

The largest individual fire was the Mudd fire. This incident was also a lightning caused fire ignited on August 9th. This fire was located 8 miles north of Mountain Home, Idaho and grew to 124,583 acres, but was contained quickly by August 13th.

The longest duration fire of the season was the Little Queens fire located 6 miles NW of Atlanta, Idaho. This fire is still under investigation, but it believed to be human caused. Little Queens was discovered on the 17th of August, burned for 111 days, totaling 26,500 acres.

The graph below shows large fires by month. The numbers are consistent with the typical pattern for large fire occurrence in Eastern Great Basin. The graph illustrates the majority of our large fires occurring during the driest and warmest months of the summer, when the fuels are most available to large fire growth.



Large Fire Activity Review

Per the National Mobilization Guide, a large fire is a wildland fire managed for complete perimeter control (Full Suppression) that is 100 acres or larger in timber fuel types and 300 acres or larger in grass or brush fuel types. There are other incidents that require ICS-209s, but the chart below only includes fires that meet the 100+/300+ description sorted by start date of the incident.




Prescribed Fire Review




Prescribed Acres Completed by State

Resource Order Summary

Statistics for 2013 resources orders have been acquired directly from the TOSS Cognos data base. Data pulled with emphasis strictly on Eastern Great Basin activity; including resources moving into and traveling outside of Eastern Great Basin. During 2013, the dispatch community in Eastern Great Basin entered 70,425 requests, 1252 orders were deleted and 53,636 were filled; or approximately 77% of requests. This number is an indication of moderate competition for resources with an active fire season in multiple geographic areas.

Requests have been separated into four categories: Aircraft, Crews, Equipment and Overhead.
