

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
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Weather 2014 – Near Record Wet



Total Precipitation Anomaly

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


Notable Weather Events

- Many new record low maximum temperatures were set across Utah during late July and August.
- Record low temperatures were set in eastern Idaho during July.
- Both Twin Falls and Jerome had their wettest August on Record.
- Multiple tropical storms from the eastern Pacific enhanced the effects of the normal monsoonal flow into the Great Basin, especially during August and September resulting in widespread, sometime heavy precipitation.


Western Idaho Mtns:

ERC's were high during June then tracked near normal through July before dropping to below normal during August.




Southwest Idaho:

Southeast Idaho:


ERC's were very high through much of June, near normal through July then decreased significantly during August.



Fire Summary by the Great Basin

Eastern and Western Great Basin had an average year for fire occurrence and a markedly below average year for total acres burned during 2014. There were 2,181 fires reported, burning a combined total acres of 158,288.



EGB comparison with Historical Averages

As of October 10th, Eastern Great Basin was within 85% of the 5 year average and 77% of the 20 year average for fire starts. However, acres burned were radically less than normal at 12% of the 5 year average and 14% of the 20 year average!




Preparedness Level Review

Eastern Great Basin's preparedness level was elevated from 1 to 2 on June 12, incidentally one day earlier than during the 2013 season. This was consistent with historical Preparedness Levels. It remained there until June 20th when it dropped back down to PL 1.

On July 1st we began to see an increase in fire activity with lower precipitation amounts, higher RHs and increasing ERCs that warranted an elevation to PL 2. This trend continued on and on July 15 Eastern Great basin elevated our Preparedness Level to PL 3 followed by PL 4 on July 25th where it remained for 3 days. It was during this time where we began to see a departure from our "normal" conditions with unseasonable but forecasted moisture. Eastern Great Basin's Preparedness Level was reduced to PL 3 on July 28th, PL 2 on August 2nd and finally PL 1 on August 22nd where it remained for the duration of the fire season.



I have included the National Preparedness level markers on the display below to illustrate how the National situation was fairly consistent with the conditions experienced in the Great Basin. The only notable exception was the above normal fire occurrence in the Northwest. The subsequent graph of the fires by month is interesting as it virtually mirrors the preceding illustration.




Year End Totals by Cause

Fire statistics for this report were pulled from the SIT report. The statistics have not been reconciled with 1202s or FIRESTAT. Eastern Great Basin reported 1,705 fires for 103,996 acres. 773 of those starts were human caused while 932 were natural fires. Historically, 40% of all fires reported are human caused. For 2014, the human caused fires were slightly above that average at 45.3%.




Human Caused Fires by Agency






Lightning Caused Fires by Agency



Note, consistent with the Incident Management Situation Report, the graph rounds to the nearest acre and will not show the tenths of acres in the total acreage.





Total Number of Fires by State





Total Number of Acres Burned by State

Large Fire Occurrence by Month


The first large fire of the year was the Stewart Lake. The Stewart Lake fire was a 335 acre human caused fire located ½ mile south of Jensen, Utah. It started on April 11th, 12 days later than our first large fire in 2013.

The largest fire of the year was the Preacher incident for 33,867 acres. The lightning caused fire 10 miles northeast of Richfield, ID started on July 14th and was contained on 7/21/2014.


The graph below shows large fire activity by month. The numbers indicate a significant departure from the normal pattern for large fire occurrence within Eastern Great Basin. August is the most notable deviation with only 9 large fires for the entire month

(In August) Copious precipitation fell in southern Idaho on the 5th and 6th and again from the 20th-25th when monsoonal moisture interacted with another slow-moving upper level low. Twin Falls, Idaho, recorded 5.57 in (141 mm) for the month, 5.25 in (133 mm) above normal and by far the wettest August on record and the wettest of any calendar month at any station in the Magic Valley.

Large Fire Activity Review

Per the National Mobilization Guide, a large fire is a wildland fire managed for complete perimeter control (Full Suppression) that is 100 acres or larger in timber fuel types and 300 acres or larger in grass or brush fuel types. There are other incidents that require ICS-209s, but the chart below only includes fires that meet the 100+/300+ description sorted by start date of the incident.

Resource Order Summary

During 2014, the dispatch community in the Great Basin entered 48,157 requests, 800 orders that were deleted, and we were able to fill 44,456 or approximately 92% of requests. This number is an indication of the limited competition for resources with an inactive fire season in most geographic areas. In comparison to 2013 when Eastern Great Basin alone entered 70,425 requests and filled 53,636, 2014 was a mild year for mobilization.



