Summary Information

The Great Basin Coordination Center (GBCC) is the focal point for coordinating the mobilization of resources for wildland fire, and other incidents throughout the Great Basin Geographic Area. The Great Basin Geographic Area encompasses Utah, Nevada, Idaho (South of the Salmon River), the Western Wyoming Mountains, and the Arizona Strip. GBCC is located in Salt Lake City, UT and provides Intelligence, and Predictive Services related products, for use by the wildland fire community for incident management decision-making.

GBCC Annual Fire Report General Information

GBCC is responsible for compiling fire reports for all *large* wildland fires on lands administered by the following five federal agencies: BLM, BIA, USFS, FWS, NPS, and state agencies. A *large* fire is defined as greater than 100 acres in forest fuel types, and greater than 300 acres in shrub and grass fuel types. Annual figures of total fire ignitions (regardless of size), and acres burned for individual units are also included.

Statistics used in this report were gathered from the Fire and Aviation Management Web applications (FAMWEB) System (which includes the Situation Report and Incident Status Summary {ICS-209} Programs, and from the Interagency Resource Ordering Capability (IROC). The statistics presented here, are intended to provide a geographic area perspective of annual fire activity and may not reflect official figures for a specific agency.








Weather 2022: Record Dry Early/Wettest Monsoon in Years








Notable Weather Events


- The 2022 Fire Season was preceded by an extremely dry spring and winter, with expectations of an early and severe fire season across southern and central areas.
- Below normal carryover fuel-load existed in most southern areas, with heavier fuels in the higher elevations being near record dry levels. A small area of good fine fuel loading in southwest ldaho and far northwestern Nevada was also a big concern.
- Fire season began 2 weeks sooner than normal (late May) across southern Utah and the Arizona Strip with initial attack quickly increasing but little "Large Fire Activity" due to sparse fine fuels.
- Several lightning events, followed by dry breezy conditions, increased large fire activity across southern areas significantly in early June.
- By mid-June however, an extremely early start to the monsoon season began across southern areas about 2-3 weeks earlier than normal. The monsoon season was long and wet for the geographic area with most southern areas receiving 120% 200% of normal rainfall.
- By Mid-July a widespread lightning event occurred, with new large fires emerging from eastern Nevada and Western Utah on up into the Central Idaho Mountains. Another dry lightning event in Idaho later in August produced even more large fires on into early September.
- The late Summer and Early Fall period kept existing large fires somewhat active into early October.

Fire Summary for the Great Basin

The Great Basin had a below average year for fire occurrence and total acres burned during 2022. There were 2,126 fires reported, burning a combined total of 431,504 acres.







Woodtick fire, ID-SCF, September 4, 2022, from Middle Fork Peak lookout

Great Basin Comparison with Historical Averages

The Great Basin experienced 84% of the 5-year average and 85% of the 15-year average for ignitions. 2022 fell below the average of acres burned, burning 60% of the 5-year and 49% of the 15-year averages.






Preparedness Level Review

Great Basin's Preparedness Level was elevated from 1 to 2 on June 22nd, approximately two weeks later than the 2021 season; this timeframe is average compared to the historical increase from PL 1 to PL 2.

On July 11th, the Great Basin's Preparedness Level increased to PL 3, approximately one month later than 2021. The increase was in conjunction with a spike in initial attack and resource commitment. The geographic area remained at PL 3 for twenty-eight days (until August 7th) when preparedness level returned to PL 2 for nine days then returned to PL 3 for another twenty-two days. An increase in additional activity and demand for resources forced the Great Basin to elevate to PL 4 on September 8th for six days before returning to PL 3 on September 14th for an additional nine days. On September 23rd we returned to PL 2 then on to PL 1 on October 12th.






Year End Totals by Cause

Fire statistics for this report were pulled from the iNAP SIT Report. The statistics have not been reconciled with 1202s, INFORM, or other final fire reporting systems. Great Basin reported 2,126 fires for 431,504 acres, with 1,177 of those starts being human caused while 949 were natural ignitions.




Fires by Class Size





Large Fire Activity Review

Per the National Mobilization Guide, a large fire is a wildland fire managed for complete perimeter control (Full Suppression), that is 100 acres or larger in timber fuel types, and 300 acres or larger in grass or brush fuel types. There are other incidents that require ICS-209s, but the chart below includes only fires that meet the 100+/300+ criteria and sorted by state and start date of the incident.



Large Fire Occurrence by Month

The first large fire of the year was the "East Road incident" on March 31st, in Churchill County, NV. The East Road was a 308-acre human caused fire, located ten miles southwest of Lovelock, NV.

The largest fire of the year was the "Moose incident" on July 17th. The human caused US Forest Service, Salmon-Challis Forest fire, was located twenty-one miles north of Salmon, ID and burned 130,205 acres. It was contained/controlled on November 17th.


The graph below indicates large fire activity by month. The numbers align with a general pattern for large fire occurrence within the Great Basin. There were a couple "early starts" to the typical large fire season during March and April, which persisted for a few days.




