



## Evening Brief

Date/Time Stamp: **Monday, August 10, 2015 - 9:16 PM**

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### Weather Summary

Monsoonal moisture will increase across the eastern two thirds of the Great Basin from the south beginning this afternoon. There is the potential for isolated dry thunderstorms across portions of northwest Utah, northern Nevada and southern Idaho.

Deep moisture will continue to surge northward across the eastern 2/3 of the Great Basin through midweek bringing an increase in storm coverage each afternoon through about Wednesday or Thursday. Storms will become increasingly wet as deeper moisture makes its way north.

Winds will begin to increase on Wednesday and Thursday particularly across western Nevada. There is the potential for critical fire weather conditions to develop on Thursday afternoon across western Nevada due to gusty winds and low relative humidity.

## Great Basin Fire Potential Summary

Fire danger will remain low across the northern and eastern portions of the Great Basin due to recent wet weather. Fire danger may rise briefly across the Great Basin through Tuesday as drier air moves into the area. However, moisture will return to the eastern portion of the Great Basin midweek, decreasing fire danger across the east while fire danger slowly trends upwards across the west.
