Weather Summary

***** Return to Dry and Breezy Northern NV / ID Saturday into Next week *****

Hot temperatures continue this week, along with continued very low humidity levels. Temperatures will be above 100 degrees in the valleys across the Great Basin. Afternoon humidity will drop into the single digits across much of NV and UT, and 10-17% most other areas further north into ID/WY. In addition, poor RH recoveries are expected at night, across thermal belts in mid-upper slopes.

As high pressure shifts north and west into Central NV this week, and the clockwise flow around the High will bring higher level sub-tropical moisture into much of the Great Basin. The moisture spreads into southern NV/southwest UT and the Sierra today, then spreads further north and east Fri-Sun. **Fuels are extremely dry (see Fuels/Fire Potential). Lightning coverage is the biggest uncertainty, however even isolated lightning will likely have high ignition efficiency.**

Moisture will deepen across Southern NV, the AZ strip and UT later this weekend into next week, decreasing large fire risk, especially across the southeastern 2/3 of UT. However, much of central and northern NV into ID, northern UT/WY will see a mix of wet and dry lightning, on top of near record dry fuels followed by a quick drying trend. **Winds also pick up this weekend into early next week across parts of western/northern NV into ID/WY, as drier air pushes in from west to east.**

- No Buying Teams are available within the geographic area.
- National and initial attack resources within the Great Basin are heavily committed. Competition for resources is substantial.
