Weather Summary

***** High Risk for Post Cold Front NW Winds Over Recent Lightning Saturday for much of ID/ Wrn WY/ NE NV and Nrn UT *****

***** High Risk for Lightning Monday across Western and Northern NV *****

A dry cold front will drop south into ID/WY/northern NV/northern UT and push south into eastern NV/rest of UT Saturday. Winds will shift to the North to Northwest, and even to the Northeast over northern Nevada behind the front and could be quite gusty at times. Current models suggest wind gusts 30-40+ mph are possible.

Dry weather will move into the northern half of the Great Basin behind the front through much of the weekend, however moisture remains in place over the southern half of the Great Basin for continued showers and thunderstorms.

Moisture will begin to push north again across NV/UT Sunday possibly as far north as the Sierra Front on Sunday, then spread north into early next week. Latest computer models suggest a fairly widespread area of mixed wet and dry lightning across much of Nevada, with **High Risk issued for Monday** in areas that have the **best combination** of lightning, minimal rainfall, and dry fuels.

Great Basin Fire Potential Summary

ERC's are still very high with many areas above the 97th percentile across the north and west where conditions have remained generally dry. Continued wet thunderstorms will continue over eastern and southern UT into southern NV, with fire danger remaining low as moisture remains in those areas.

Fire potential will increase across ID/WY/UT/northern NV Friday as a cold front moves through from the north and brings gusty north winds to the region. Fire potential may increase further south on Friday night / Saturday as the front moves into eastern NV/UT.

Some of our driest fuels are across Wrn NV, where lightning is expected early next week.

A Fuel and Fire Behavior Advisory is also in effect for the Northern half of Nevada, Southwest Idaho and Northwest Utah.
