## Evening Brief

Date/Time Stamp: **Wednesday, August 24, 2016 - 10:50 AM**

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### Weather Summary

\*\*\* Breezy and Dry In Areas of Recent Lightning (Nrn NV) and Ongoing Fires (Srn ID/Wrn WY) \*\*\*

A cold front pushing down from the north will bring breezy NW winds across ID/WY and Nrn NV/UT today. Winds will reach 15 to 30 mph by this afternoon long with RH of 8-15% in many areas. The concern is that these winds and low RH could push existing fires as well as encourage new fires from recent lightning.

Southern UT/NV should see scattered showers and wet thunderstorms today into Wed. Late tonight into Wed a "backdoor" cold front should push some showers across Wrn WY/Ern ID and Ern UT...briefly modifying fire potential.

Gradual warming and drying expected late in the week into the upcoming weekend.

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### Great Basin Fire Potential Summary

ERC's have rapidly risen to near or beyond the 97th percentile across a large portion of ID. With ongoing fires in ID and Wrn WY there is the potential for significant growth. Winds there today will be problematic...not quite strong enough for "High Risk" but gusts 20-30 mph possible from the NW later today.



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Elsewhere nearly as dry across Wrn WY and Nrn NV-Nrn UT with most ERC's in the 90th-97th percentiles. Wrn NV had significant lightning activity the past 48 hrs and there is the potential for holdovers today with westerly breezes of 15-25 mph and single digit afternoon humidity.

Moist conditions are expected to continue across Srn portions of UT/NV.

**A Fuel and Fire Behavior Advisory** is also in effect for the Northern half of Nevada, Southern Idaho and Northwest Utah.
