Weather Summary

***** Breezy In Areas of Ongoing Fires (Southern ID/ Western WY) *****

***** Isolated Dry Lightning Today over Central/Southeast ID into WY *****

A weak front will drop south into ID today bringing **isolated mixed wet/dry thunderstorms** extending across southeast ID into western WY. The best chances for lightning look to be east of the Pioneer Fire, but lightning and/or gusty outflow winds may affect all other fires in ID/WY today. Isolated showers/thunderstorms continue Thursday over southeast ID into western WY, but better chances of rainfall and higher RH will occur Thursday over western WY.

Otherwise, **breezy winds** will continue today across ID with winds shifting to the N-NE north of a line from Boise, ID to Jackson, WY. NW winds will continue south of the line over southern ID into northern UT. Winds 10-15 mph with gusts around 25 mph are expected today with Min RH 12-16%. Some higher gusts may occur near thunderstorms or over far eastern ID into WY.

Yesterday's cold front is pushing south into UT with less overall lightning/moisture. However, lightning will quickly increase with better chances of **wetting rain** over the southern half of UT into far southern/southeast NV Thursday through Sunday.

Gradual warming and drying expected late in the weekend into next week.

Great Basin Fire Potential Summary

ERC's have rapidly risen to near or beyond the 97th percentile across a large portion of ID into far northern NV/UT. With ongoing fires in ID and WY into northern UT there is the potential for significant growth still in the coming days. Winds there today will be problematic...not quite strong enough for "High Risk" but NW-NE wind gusts 20-30 mph expected again today with lighter winds Thursday.

Isolated lightning may also return to ID/WY today and Thursday with the potential for new ignitions and gusty outflow winds affecting ongoing incidents.

Moist conditions are expected to continue across Srn portions of UT/NV.

A Fuel and Fire Behavior Advisory is also in effect for the Northern half of Nevada, Southern Idaho and Northwest Utah.
