Weather Summary

***** HIGH RISK for WIND/LOW RH eastern Nevada and western Utah SATURDAY *****


*****MUCH COOLER TEMPERATURES and SHOWERS to Idaho western Wyoming and northern Nevada on Sunday*****

High Risk for Winds/Low RH through Sunday, however the winds will be mainly limited to Utah.

Holdover fires could pop up from yesterday's lightning activity across the eastern Great Basin as southwest winds pick up.

Maximum temperatures are already on a downward trend and will become quite cool on Sunday/Monday as the main low swings into the region. **Wetting rains** are possible over much of Idaho and western Wyoming and even the northern fringe of Nevada Sunday. High elevation snow is also possible in these areas above 8500'.

The southern half of the Great Basin will see the cooler temperatures but remain on the drier side, especially by the first part of next week as westerly flow returns.

Great Basin Fire Potential Summary

ERC's remain near or above the 97th percentile across a large portion of northern Nevada, Idaho, western Wyoming and far northern Utah, which are near/above records. With ongoing fires in Idaho and western Wyoming into northern Utah, there is the potential for significant growth still in the coming days as breezy and drier weather returns.

Moist fuel conditions are expected to continue across southern portions of Utah, Nevada and the Arizona Strip this week, with some drying Sunday into the middle of next week.
