Evening Brief

Date: Friday July 27 , 2018

Weather Summary

Hot and dry conditions will continue this weekend into early next week. Locally breezy SW winds across eastern Idaho and Southern areas of Nevada and Utah Saturday afternoon. Overall thunderstorm coverage will be decreasing through the weekend as the high pressure ridge becomes centered over the Great Basin. Hot and dry conditions will spread throughout the geographic area heading into next week.

Next chance of critical lightning will be the middle of next week, with moisture moving northward along the Nevada/Utah border from south to north, and pushing into much of Idaho, where fuels are the driest..

Fuels/Fire Potential

ERC's are still near or below the 50th percentile across the southern third of Nevada, Utah, into the AZ Strip, but even there, drier pockets are beginning to emerge, along with an occasional lightning holdover. ERC's are mainly in the 70th to 80th percentile across Northern parts of NV and UT and even drier, across Idaho, where many stations are no at or above the 90th percentile. Wyoming ERC's also steadily rising into the 60th-70th percentiles. Live Fuel Moisture levels across most areas are near late July normals, and grasses are cured in just about all areas, except the highest elevations above 6500 ft. in Idaho and Western Wyoming.
