Weather Summary:

***** High Risk Saturday-Monday for the ID Mtns & Wrn WY for Winds/Low RH *****

***** Hot/Dry Weather Spreads Eastwards this Week as Monsoon Fades *****

Drier air moves into most of the Great Basin, including the eastern areas which have seen several days of monsoonal showers & thunderstorms. Strong high pressure builds across the Great Basin with above normal midsummer temperatures.

Monsoon weakens as it shifts eastward into far eastern areas Thursday before falling apart by the end of the week. Southern and eastern areas of the Great Basin will see fuels steadily become more critical later this week into this weekend, as the hot/dry conditions spread eastward and the monsoon becomes suppressed for the time being. **High Risk for Winds/Low RH has been issued for most of the Central Idaho Mountains this weekend** as a strong cold front approaches from the northwest, bringing winds of 25-35 mph over rapidly drying fuels.

Fuels/Fire Potential:

Fuels continue to dry region-wide. Overall fire danger has increased significantly across most of Idaho and Wyoming and fuels continue to steadily dry out in Nevada, Utah, and the AZ Strip, as the monsoonal influence begins to wane. By the end of the 7-day period most areas will probably be at or above the 90th percentile and be considered "critical" for large fire potential. Existing large fires will have opportunity for continued growth.
