Coeur d'Alene Interagency Dispatch Center (ID-CDC)

The 2023 season was the 25th season of operation for the Coeur d'Alene Interagency Dispatch Center (CDC) Staffing shortages made for a challenging year. The following provides a brief overview of the season's statistics and activity.

CDC STAFFING

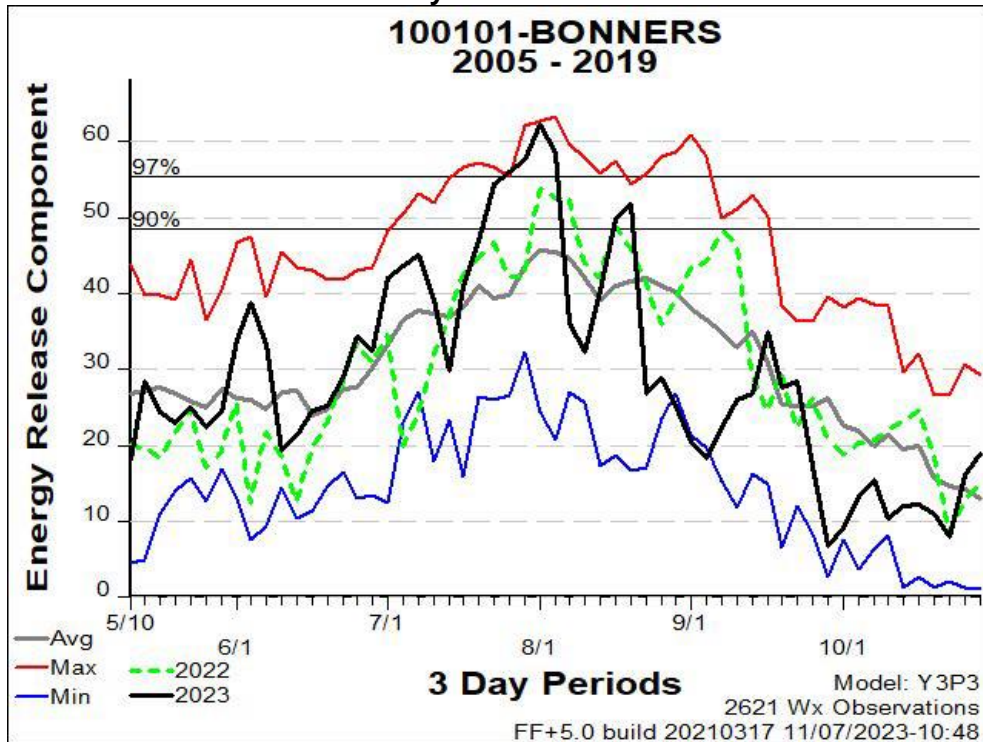

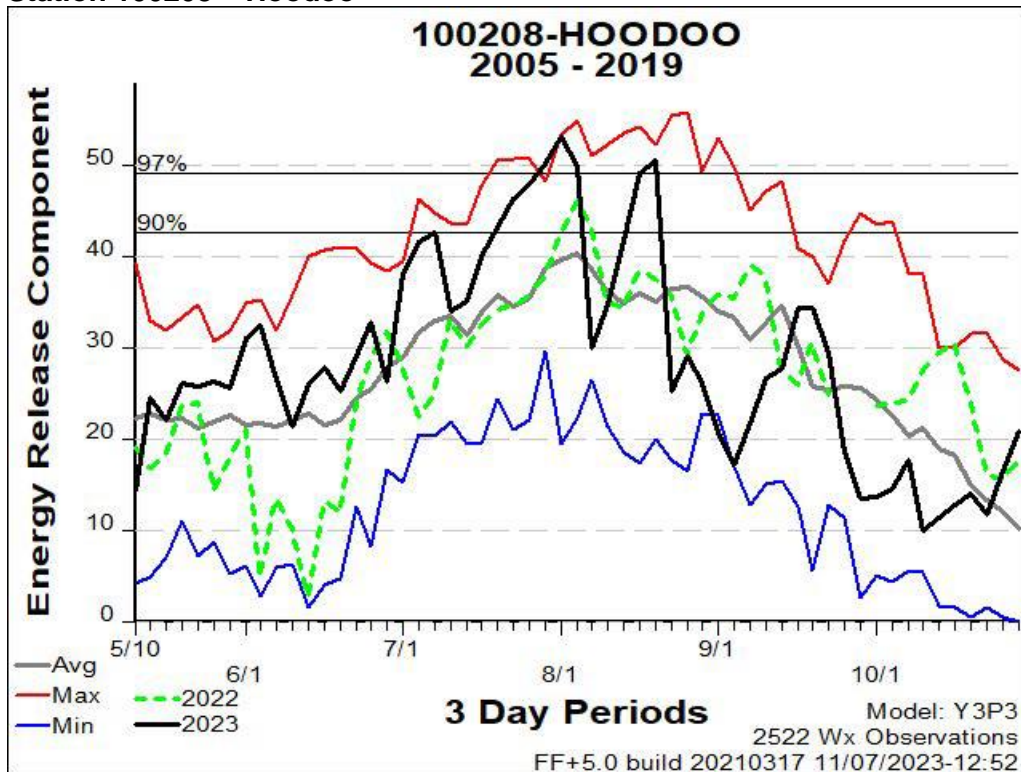
Station 100107 – Saddle Pass



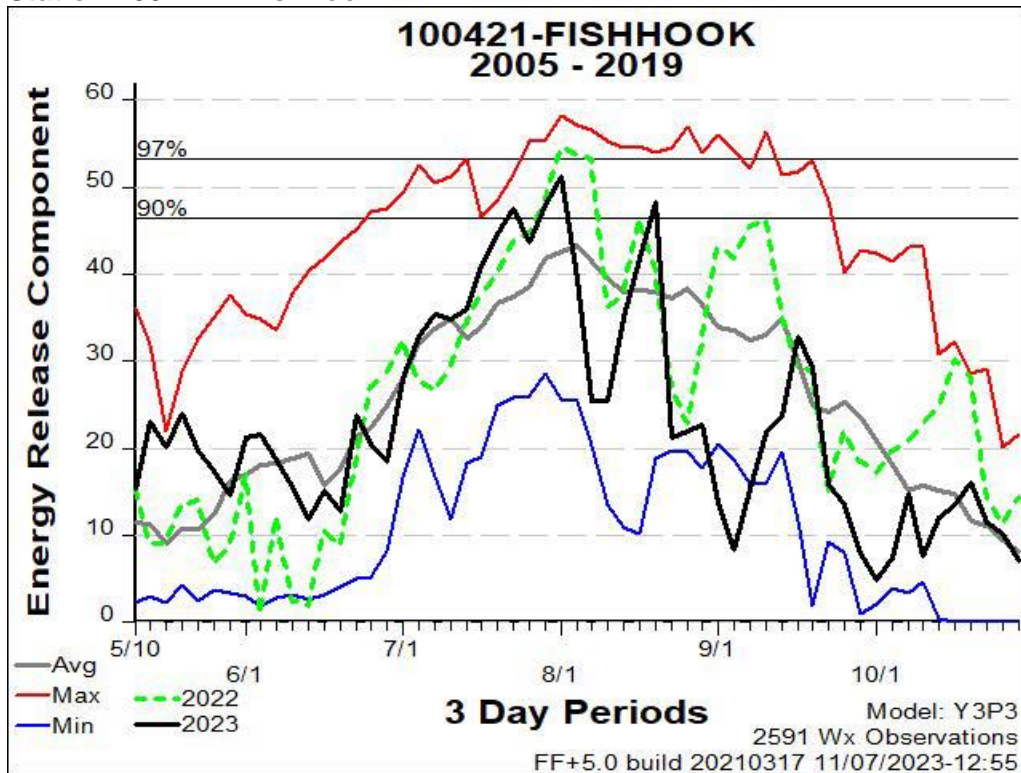
Station 100204 – Priest Lake



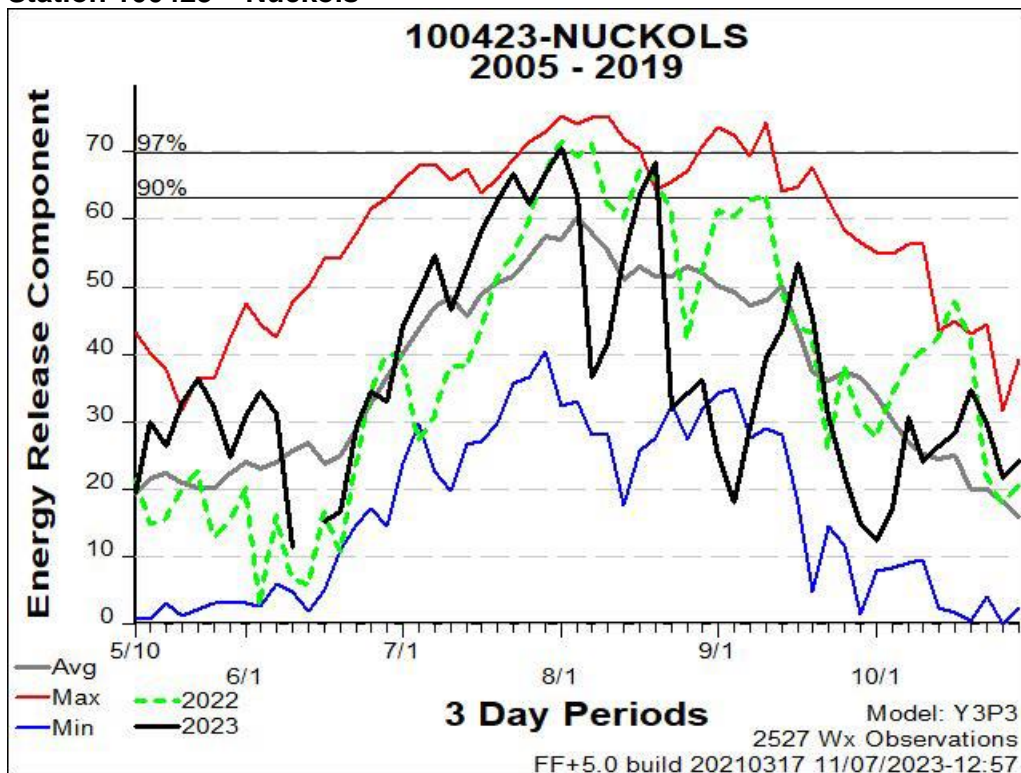

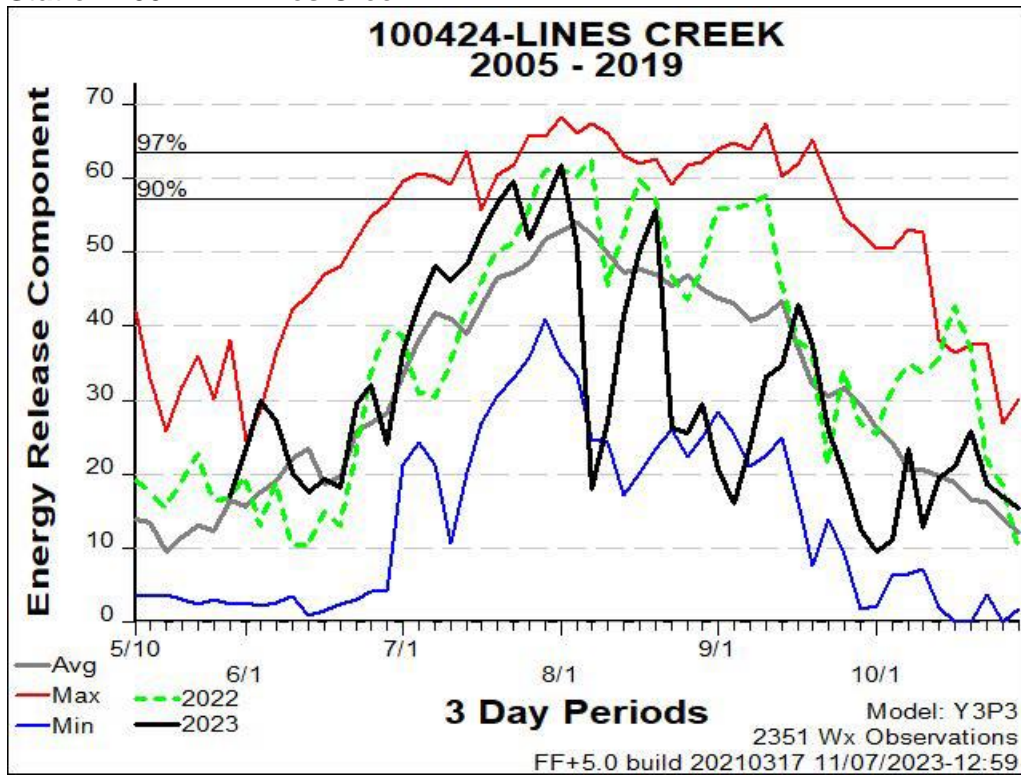

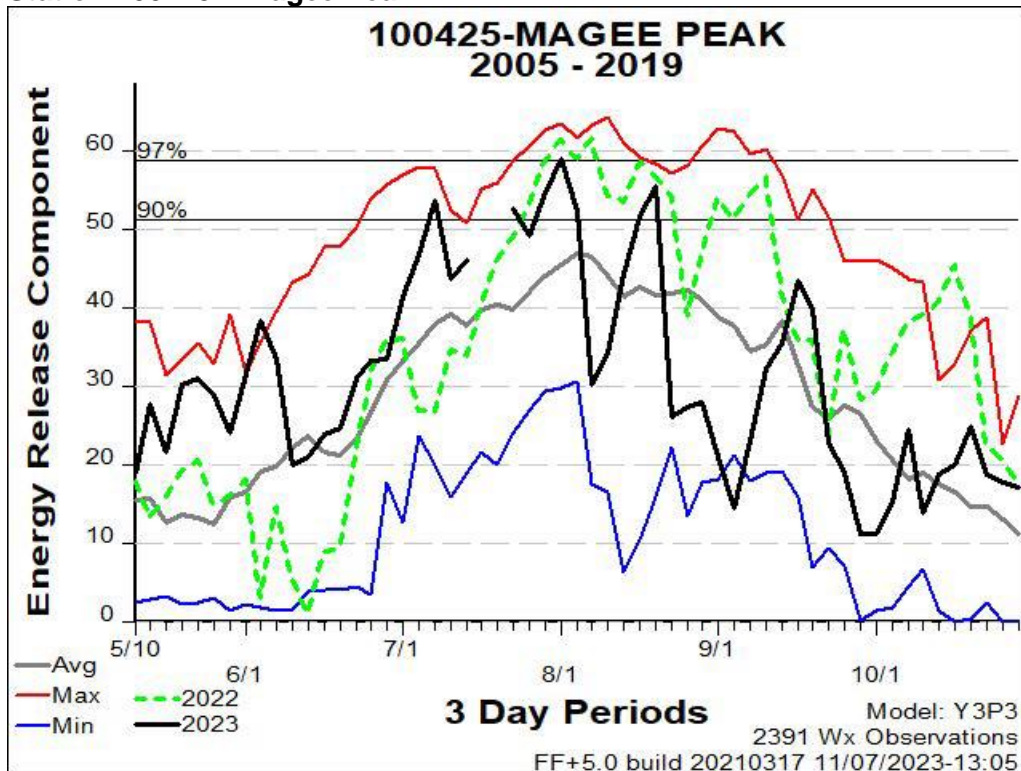
Station 100423 – Nuckols



Station 100424 – Lines Creek

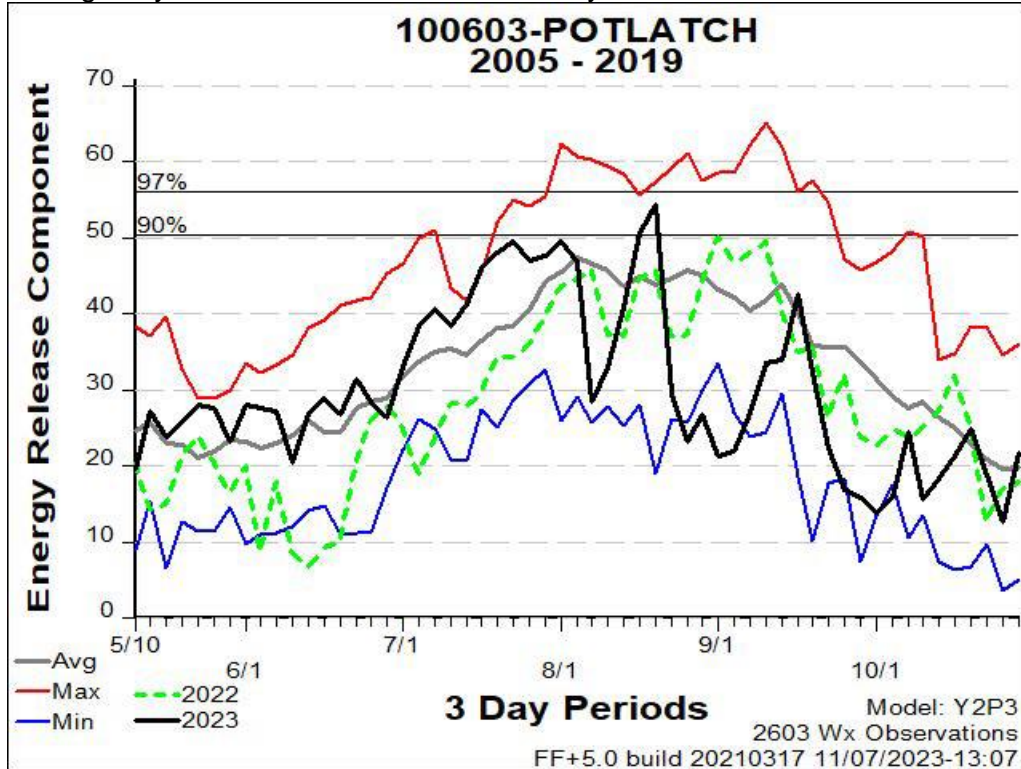

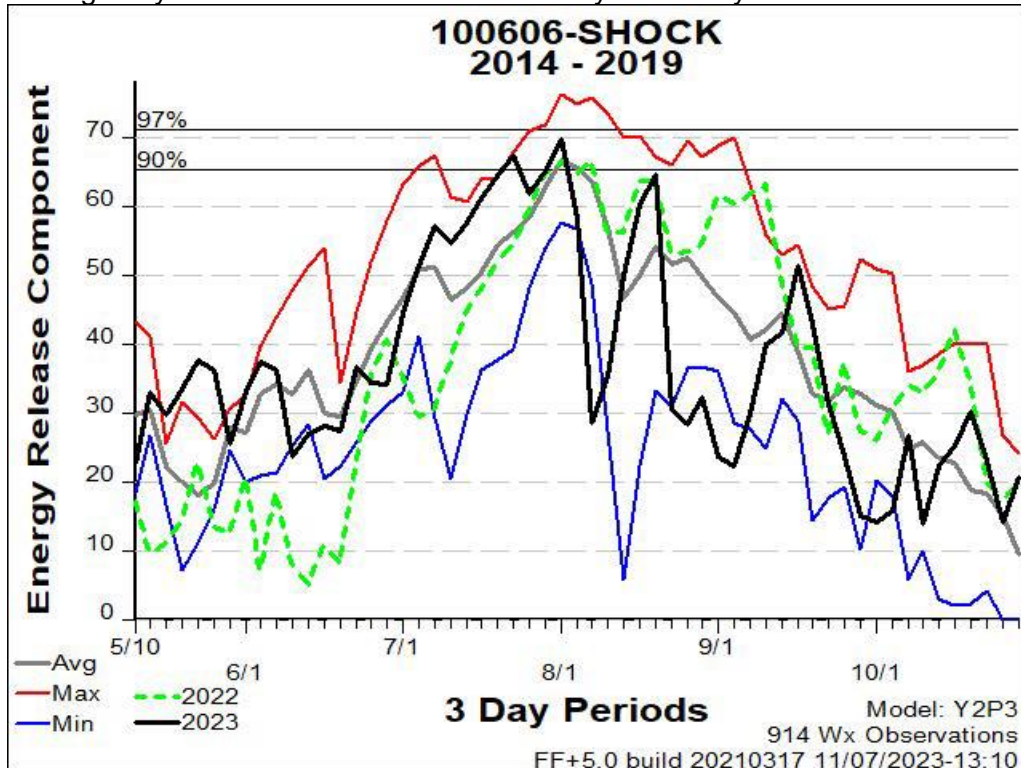

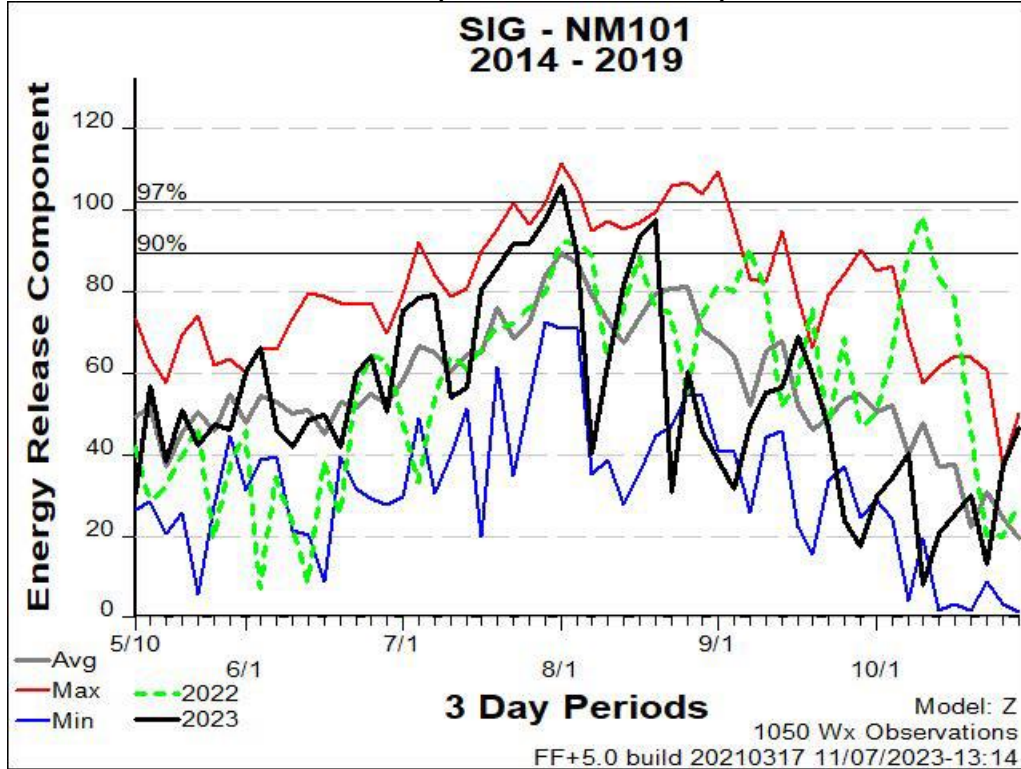


Station 100606 – Shock

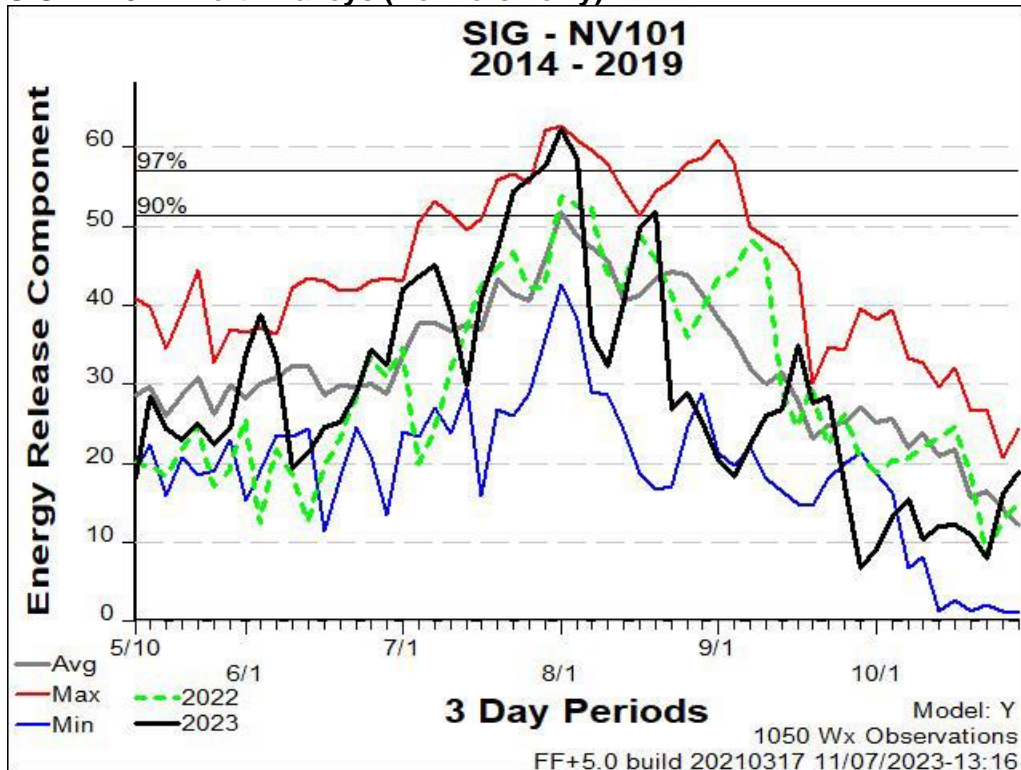

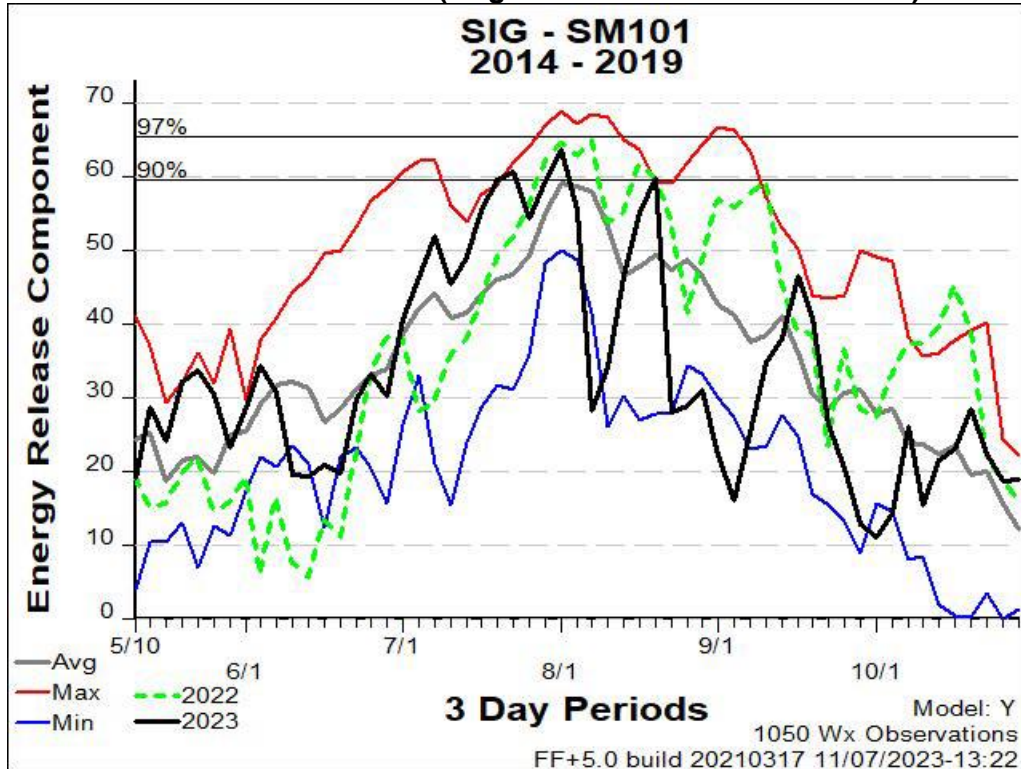
SIG NM101 – North Mountains (Priest Lake/Hoodoo)



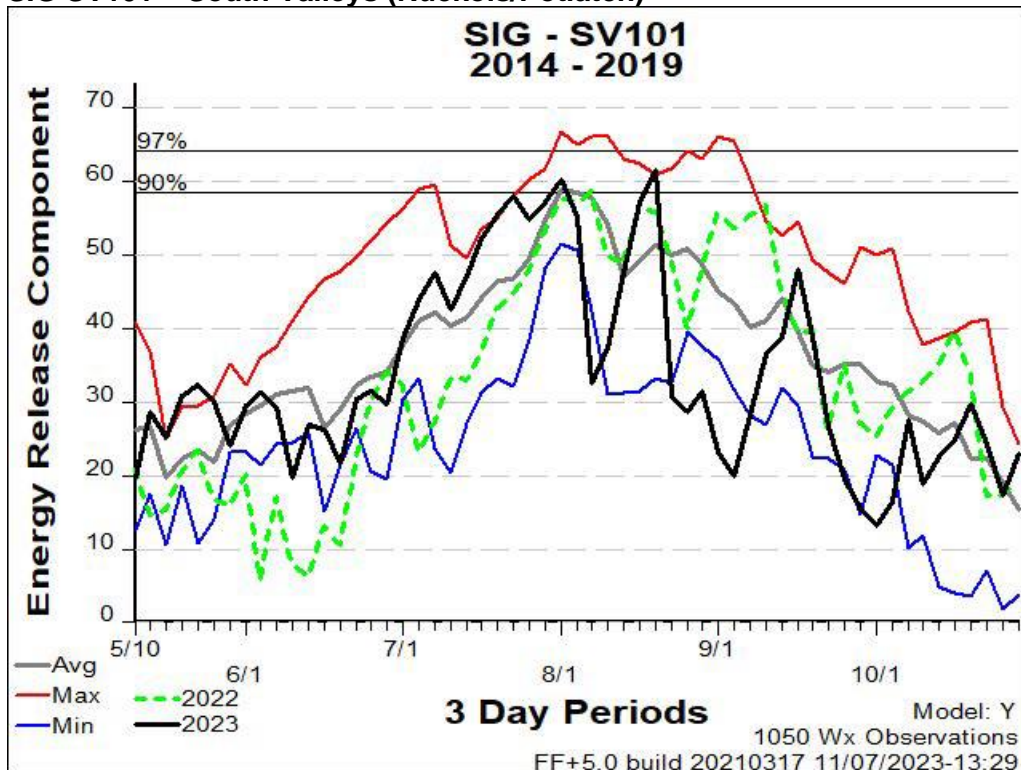
SIG NV101 – North Valleys (Bonners Ferry)



SIG SM101 – South Mountains (Magee Peak/Nuckols/Lines Creek)

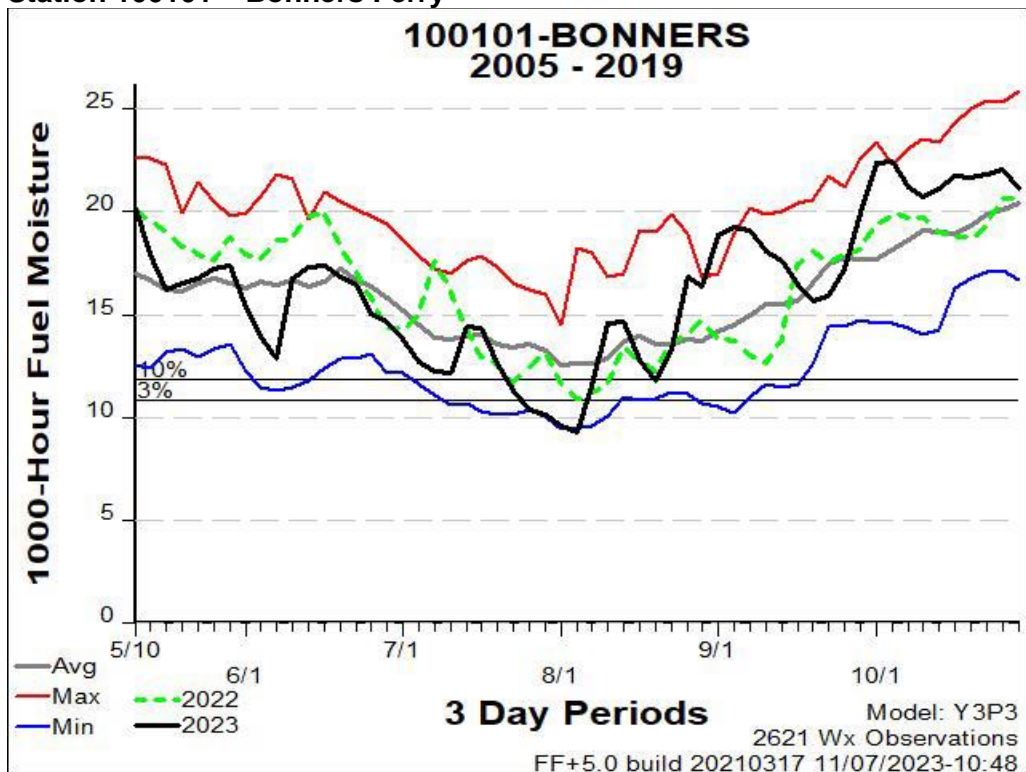


SIG SV101 – South Valleys (Nuckols/Potlatch)

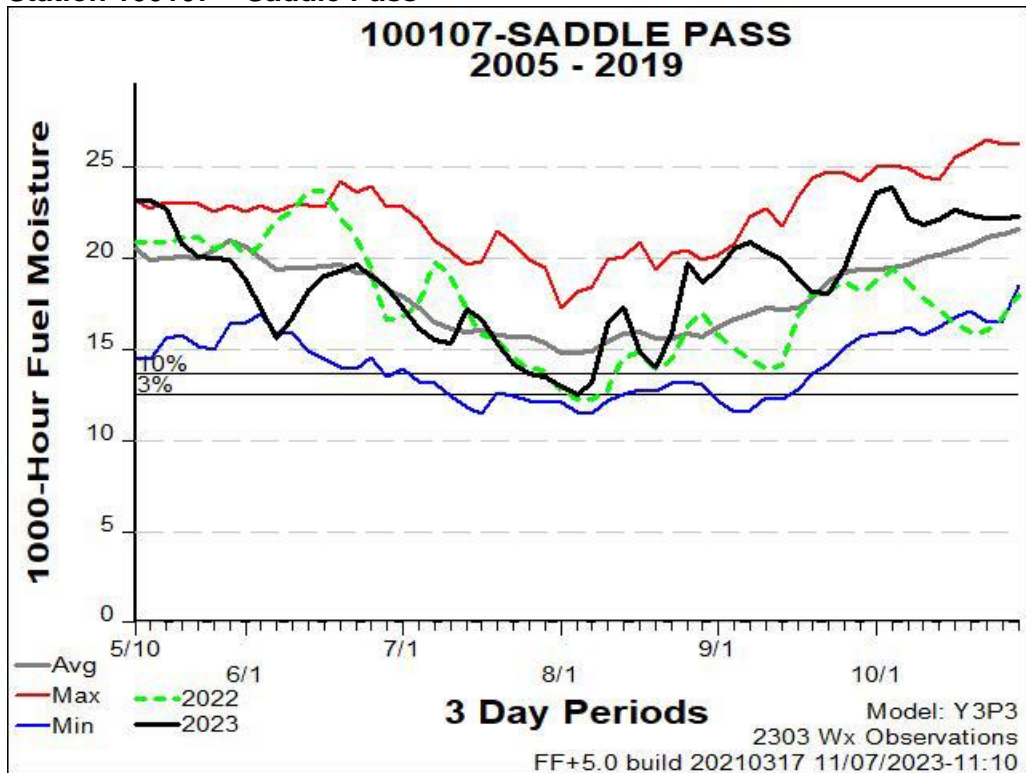

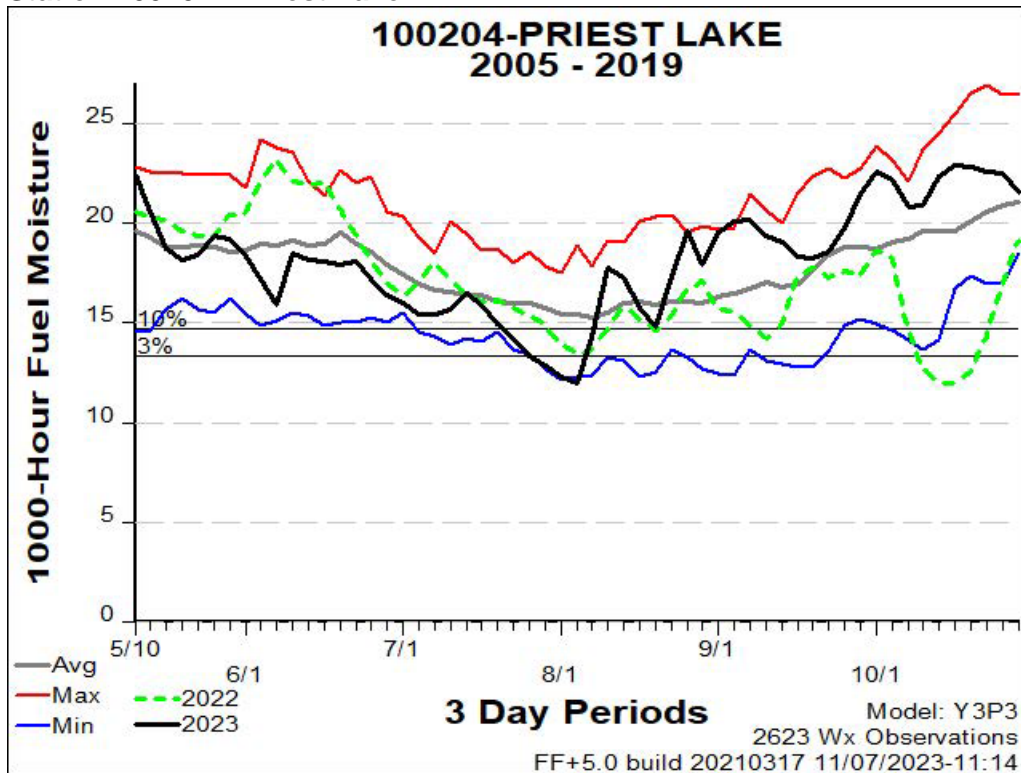

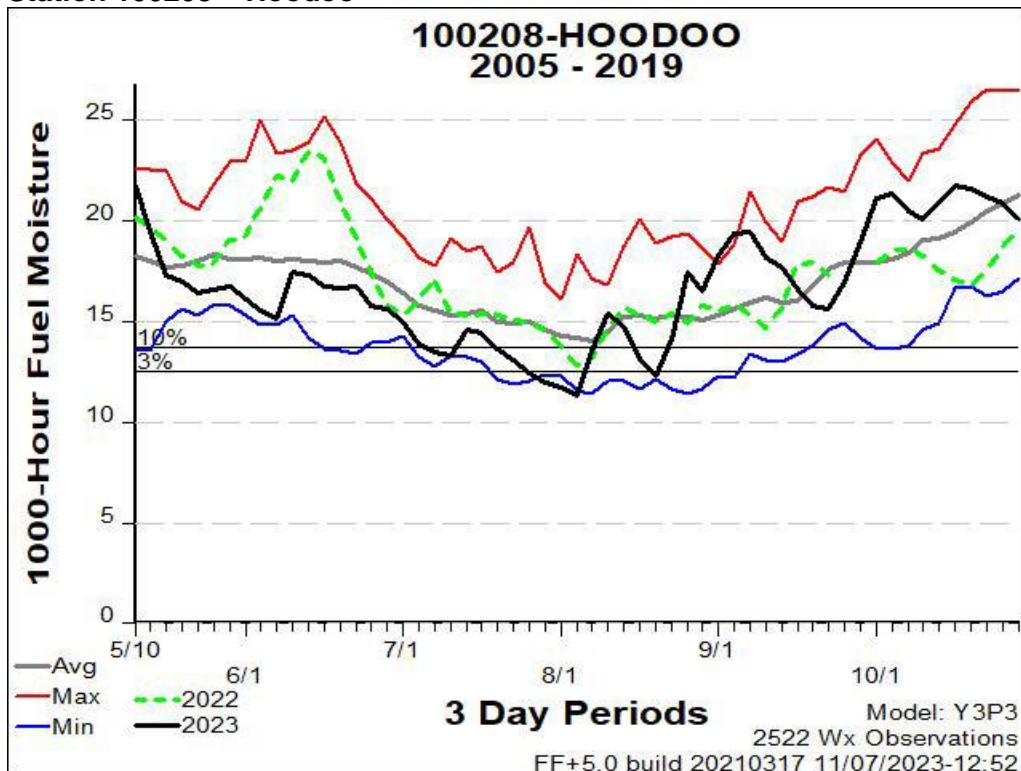
Station 100107 – Saddle Pass



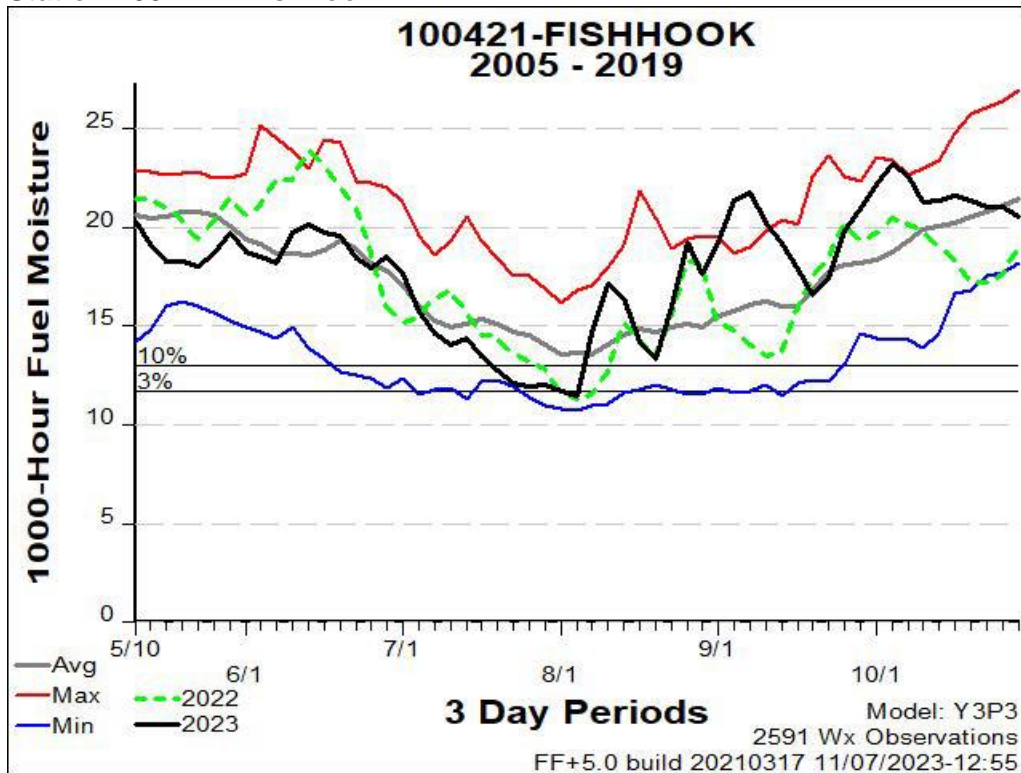
Station 100204 – Priest Lake



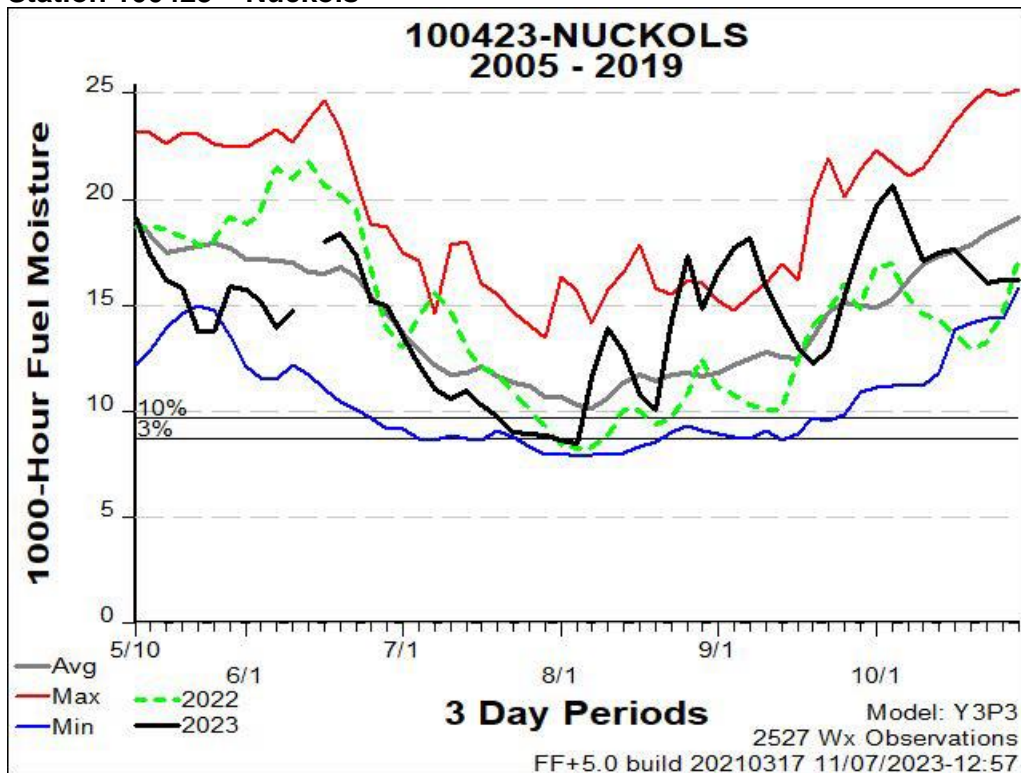

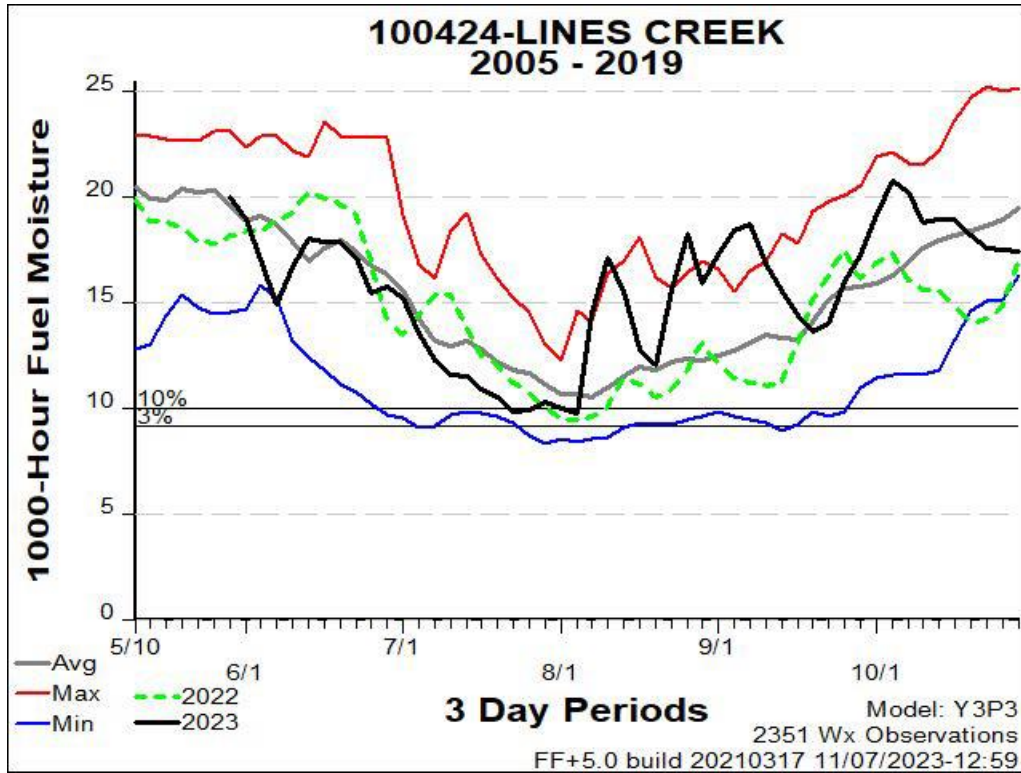
Station 100421 – Fishhook



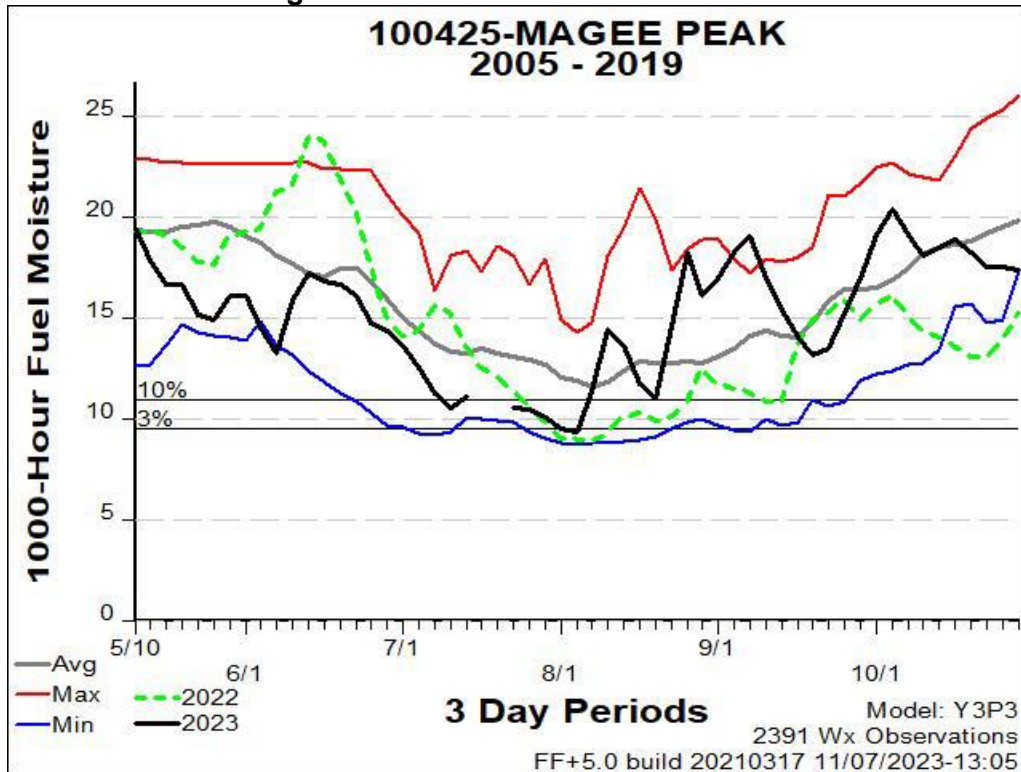
Station 100423 – Nuckols

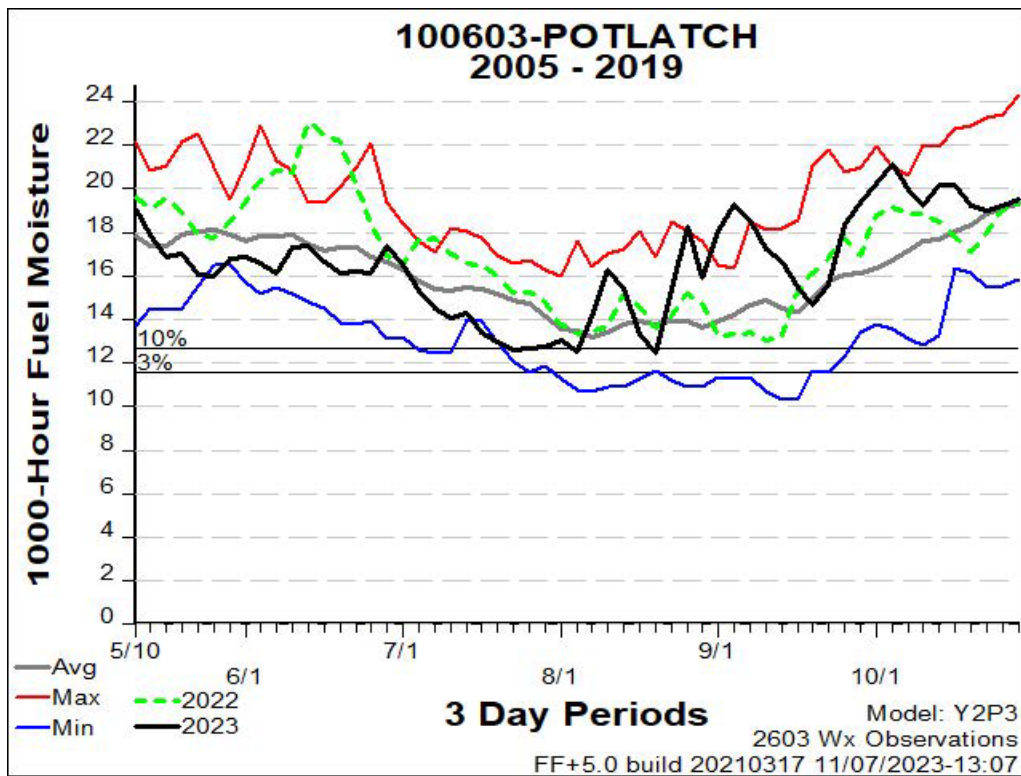


Station 100425 – Magee Peak
