.DISCUSSION...

...THIS IS THE LAST FIRE WEATHER FORECAST FOR THE SEASON...

Windy conditions will develop today as a cold front moves through. Stronger wind gusts will be possible on the ridgetops in the Idaho Panhandle. Rain is expected to fall in the Idaho Panhandle. Northwest flow and Polar Jet are to remain in close proximity allowing cooler air to seep into the region at times and disturbances to bring occasional precipitation chances. Overall, near seasonal temperatures will be trending cooler than normal going into next week.

.Today...

- * Sky/Weather.....Partly sunny. Slight chance of rain in the morning, then chance of rain in the afternoon.
- * LAL.....1.
- * Max Temperature.....51-61 valleys and 43-53 mountains.
- * Min Humidity.....55-70 percent valleys and 61-80 percent mountains.
- * 20-foot winds.....
- * Valleys/Lwr Slopes...Southwest 9 to 18 mph. Gusts up to 30 mph in the morning increasing to 45 mph in the afternoon.
- * Ridges/Upr Slopes....Southwest 10 to 21 mph with gusts to around 45 mph in the afternoon.
- * Haines Index.....2 or very low.
- * CWR (> 0.10 IN).....50 percent.

.TONIGHT...

- * Sky/Weather.....Mostly cloudy. Chance of rain through the night.
- * LAL.....1.
- * Min Temperature.....32-42.
- * Max Humidity.....81-100 percent.
- * Humidity Recovery...Excellent.
- * 20-foot winds.....
- * Valleys/Lwr Slopes...West 8 to 19 mph with gusts to around 40 mph in the evening shifting to the northwest 4 to 9 mph with gusts to around 20 mph overnight.
- * Ridges/Upr Slopes....West 10 to 20 mph with gusts to around 40 mph in the evening.
- * Haines Index.....2 or very low.
- * CWR (> 0.10 IN).....30 percent.

.SATURDAY...

- * Sky/Weather.....Partly sunny. Chance of valley rain and mountain snow in the morning. Slight chance of valley rain and mountain snow in the afternoon.
- * LAL.....1.
- * Max Temperature.....45-54 valleys and 35-45 mountains.
- * Min Humidity.....45-60 percent valleys and 65-80 percent mountains.
- * 20-foot winds.....
- * Haines Index.....2 or very low.
- * CWR (> 0.10 IN).....10 percent.
