- DESCRIPTION: This course introduces students to the principles of the Incident Command System (ICS) associated with incident-related performance. Topics include leadership and management, delegation of authority and management by objectives, functional areas and positions, briefings, organizational flexibility, transitions and transfers.
***NOTE:** Per the FMCG (version 11/2012) The IS200 online course offered by the EMI and the Q463 online course offered by the NFA are not interchangeable with the NWCG I-200 course. The course hours are significantly reduced and NWCG feels the learning experience with the online versions do not meet the intent of I-200.*
- TARGET GROUP: First-line supervisors, single resource bosses, lead dispatchers, field supervisors, company officers, and entry level positions (trainees) on incident management teams.
- SCHEDULE: Course will begin at 0800 on Wednesday, May 29 and will conclude by 1300 on Thursday, May 30.
- COST: There will be no tuition, but trainees will be responsible for their own expenses, salary and travel.
