All teams will be filling vacant positions for the 2023 season, including trainee positions. All current team members will need to apply in addition to all new applicants. Persons interested in changing positions on a team, filling vacant positions on a team, or desiring to be alternates or trainees will need to apply. Please apply to one IMT at one position only. If applicants would like to be considered for additional IMT's or other positions, please apply to the respective IMT Pool.

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: All state, federal and local government employees within the Northern Rockies Geographic Area.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. All individuals selected for Command and General Staff positions on IMT's, including trainees, are expected to attend their team workshop, if budgets allow.
- 2. For information on the schedules, policies, team configuration, etc. refer to the **2022 Incident Management Team Plan** posted on the NRCC web site (http://gacc.nifc.gov/nrcc/dispatch/overhead/overhead.htm).
- 3. Incident Management Teams are utilized on complex incidents and face great challenges in directing interagency resources towards a common goal. When a team is on call, it is expected that team members will be available. Granted, events can occur that make individuals unavailable for assignment, but these events should be few and on a short-term basis. Please give serious consideration to the availability commitment when applying for a position on a team.
- 4. A 3-year commitment is expected for each of the Command and General Staff positions on all teams. All other positions are a 1-year commitment but, may be renewed for 3 years.
- 5. Individuals desiring to be alternates on any team must submit an updated application annually.
- 6. "Free-lancing" by team members is allowed on a case-by-case basis as agreed to by the IC.
- 7. We realize that people have personal commitments during fire season, which might affect their availability (vacations, planned leave, business meetings etc.) We will do everything possible to accommodate those needs. It is the responsibility of the team member to notify their unit / section chief and their dispatch center of any change in their availability. It is the team member's responsibility to locate an available and qualified replacement, utilizing the team alternate list, if they are unavailable for an assignment.
- 8. For those applying to Type 1 & Type 2 Command and General Staff positions if you hold the Complex Incident Management (CIM) qualification please apply to that position. Team typing will depend on the qualifications of the C&G selected. All existing Type 2 IMT's will become CIMT's if they are able to meet minimum qualifications through the current application process.

- If you **ONLY** wish to be considered for the Alternate list (for any Short or Long team position), or, would like to be considered on multiple IMT's, please apply to the IMT2/CIM Pool or IMT3 Pool options.
- All applicants must have supervisor's approval to apply for the team and position.
