- **NWCG/NMAC Update** (Aitor Bidaburu)

Upcoming Meetings:

- ICAC: October 28–29 (half day, Boise)
- CIMT AAR: October 29 (half day) and October 30 – with NMAC, CGAC, CGs, and CMs (Boise)

Information Updates:

- Expect to remain at Preparedness Level 3 with significant resource commitments still in place but trending downward. Preparedness levels will be reassessed later in the week.
- NMAC meetings are scheduled for Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.
- The DOI Secretarial Order has been released, accompanied by a joint USDA/DOI press briefing outlining efforts related to the Executive Order.

- **CGAC Report Out** (Dennis Strange) - Dennis noted that the CGAC meeting notes have been shared, and follow-up items and assignments are in progress. The group discussed identifying representatives to participate in the upcoming AAR. Key discussion points included outlining the top three factors contributing to team success and the top three issues that need to be addressed, particularly related to NMAC direction and overall oversight of teams.

- **NRCC Operations** (Corey Buhl) – No updates.

- **NRCC Update** (Kate Holsapple) – Kate reported a decrease in activity across the area this week, with widespread high humidity recovery contributing to the moderation. Some warming is expected later in the week, but current initial attack activity remains low with no emerging incidents of concern. She also provided a staffing update, noting that the same three vacancies remain: the USFS aircraft position (closing September 23), the DNRC assistance coordination position, and the FWS meteorologist position, which is moving forward in the hiring process. Work continues to identify a replacement for Jay

New Business

- **NRCG Attendance at IMT AAR Meeting** (Rogers, Lonergan) – October 29-30
 - NRCG Representation: Dennis Strange, Rich Cowger
 - The IMT AAR meeting will be held October 29–30. NRCG and ICAC will ensure thoughtful and purposeful representation at the session. Rogers and Lonergan emphasized the importance of being well-prepared, with members asked to identify the top three successes and top three issues for discussion. Items should be submitted to Dennis and Rich for review during the October NRCG meeting. Suggestions for discussion include the concept of a national team rotation.
- **2026 IMT Meeting Logistics Update** - Team 6 will be organizing the meeting using the event coordinator. Will be looking for input from all NR IMTs for agenda content.
- **IC/IMT Recruitment** (Beau Richardson, Kate Holsapple) - Beau and Kate provided an update on the upcoming IC/IMT recruitment process. Recruitment notices for Incident Commanders will be released in early October, with selections finalized by the fall NRCG meeting. The existing application form worked well, though the group discussed adding questions to capture applicant motivation and how candidates will represent the Northern Rockies. Additional consideration will be given to defining core competencies, leadership qualities, and soft skills aligned with NRCG expectations.
 - No official notifications have been received from current ICs regarding non-return, though Joe Sampson and Scott Schuster have indicated they will not reapply. A peer review process and clear expectations will be incorporated to ensure fairness and transparency.
 - **Action Item:** Beau will work with NRCG/Karly to quantify and establish key core competencies for selection. Timeline: Application period opens no later than October 10, with submissions due by October 31.
- **Fall NRCG Meeting** - The Fall NRCG Meeting is scheduled for November 5–7, with a half day on Wednesday and Friday and a full day on Thursday.
 - The group plans to spend time with NRCC during the session and identify a suitable venue or activity to support collaboration. Cerdia will also be attending the L580 course during this timeframe.
