NWCG/NMAC Update: (Aitor Bidaburu)

- Unable to participate due to scheduling conflict.
- ICAP will not be ready for use this Fall for IMT the application process. This was shared by Forest Service partners at NIFC on Monday, September 18th.

NRCG Operations (Kathy Pipkin for Corey Buhl)

- Have a couple of loads of jumpers; T1 Crews are still a national need. Northern Rockies is balancing what can be offered up for national assistance.
- NMAC has set resource allocation priorities wildfire needs within the U.S., FEMA ESF4 needs, Prescribed Fire (RX) and international assistance.
 - \circ $\;$ Do still have resources in Canada.

NRCC Update (Kathy Pipkin)

- New Center manager selected, Kate Holsapple. (For those that were not aware, Kathy Pipkin will be retiring at the end of the year.)
- NPS Intelligence Coordinator position filled with Alex Brooks.
- Morganne Lehr accepted the RIST position of Deputy Coordinator, out of Region 05.

NRCG Fall Meeting / Program Support - Informational Topic - Pam Jolly and Craig Glazier

- NRCG Program Support capacity support
 - Pam Jolly will be taking a 120 day temporary promotion. USFS is not detailing anyone in behind here due to need for realizing fiscal savings.
 - Ask if for another agency to provide this NRCG Program Support coverage during the interim.
- NRCG Fall Meeting planning:
 - Both Pintler Room at NRTC in Missoula, MT and the USFS R01 FAM meeting Owl have been reserved for NRCG Fall meeting, November 6 9, 2023.
 - \circ $\;$ Logistics for the hybrid format meeting will need to be addressed.
 - Room table arrangement.
 - Meeting Owl set up, testing and utilization.
- Craig Howells can try to find someone to fill in for Program Support capacity; however, no guarantees.
- Dennis Strange clarified that names of interested individuals need to be provided to the NRCG BOD



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by October 10, 2023. The next meeting regular NRCG Monthly meeting is on October 17, 2023.

- Rich Cowger clarified that agenda item topics for the fall meeting should be submitted to Pam Jolly as soon as possible, and at the latest by COB end of next week.
 - Intent is for the Chair to review these with Pam Jolly the following Monday.

Dispatch Improvement Tasking - Next Steps - Standing Item - Dan O'Brien

- Review two items in pre-reading materials.
- Core group came together well; Program of Work (POW) developed and is intended to be a show of transparency.
- Desire is to use the POW as a public, living document. Intent also is to publish.
 - \circ $\;$ Do not intend to publish the individual meeting notes.
- Anything requiring a decision, NRCG will be the first informed before moving forward.
- Do want to ensure group has NRCG concurrence to go direct regarding communications with the dispatch community.
- Assigning tasks:
 - Desire formal taskings out of NRCG; signed by the Chair. These will be drafted and submitted to the Chair by the group.
 - Having the ability to create groups Subject Matter Expert (SME) Groups would also be helpful, moving forward.
 - Reviewed the scope of the POW and discussed specific, BOD, line-item feedback.
- Asks:
 - Dispatch Workforce Coordinator need to further develop this proposal, in terms of what is being committed to; desire to having as an immediate task and pushed forward.
 - Tate Fischer agreed.
 - Bryce Rogers agreed.
 - Dispatch Admin Assistance do wish to pursue as an immediate task; however, not sure at this time of decision ask of BOD.
 - Desire the ability to task Predictive Services and/or agency research units to identify what Norther Rockies expects regarding activity and workload level planning over the next five to ten years.
- Discussion only around BOD endorsement of above planning. Will create formal proposals for official BOD vote during the October NRCG Monthly meeting.
 - o General BOD consent and support expressed for continuing to pursue above outlined POW.
