Documentation of NW MAC Decisions

Strategic Intent:

1. Allocate Type 1 crews and Large Air Tankers to sufficiently staff new large incidents in WA state, while meeting needs of established large fires
2. Be prepared to export resources for the next 72 hours
3. Position Initial Attack resources as needed to support large fires until needed for IA

PNW Incident Priorities (*set once per day*):

| 4. Oak Flat | OR-RSF | Fillis | Difficult terrain and mining claims |
| 5. White Lightning Complex | OR-WSA | West | Transitioning to Type 3 Organization tomorrow |
