Strategic Intent:

- Collaborate and provide support for SW OR Sub GEO MAC.
- Support ongoing initial attack and provide support for replacements to meet long- term resource needs.
- Provide support for incidents with short-duration critical missions.

2	Douglas Complex	OR-DFPA (732)	Sifford	SW OR MAC	Multiple values at risk; unsecured line with potential growth to the southwest; reducing evacuation levels
3	Big Windy Complex	OR-MED	Schulte	SW OR MAC	Continue with big box strategy; firing operations ongoing; established evacuation level 1 for Galice
4	Green Ridge-Cascade Division complex	OR-DEF	Minton		Indirect strategy on the south and west flank; containment date predicted for 8/12; spotting to the east threatening private property
5	Whiskey Complex	OR-UPF	Williams	SW OR MAC	High concern for industrial/timber lands; firing operations ongoing; received light precipitation on the fire
6	Colockum Tarps	WA-WFS	Nickey		High probability of containment; no critical resource needed; burn out should be completed today; transitioning to T3 on 8/11 or 12
