Strategic Intent:

- Follow Strategic Risk Assessment as necessary.
- Plan Type 1 crew utilization to meet critical burn-out missions across the GACC.
- Continue to allocate/reallocate critical resources in support of IA, emerging large fires and incidents with short duration critical missions.
