| 2 | Government Flat Complex | OR-954S | Cline | | Control lines established; direct attack strategy; securing spot fires |
| 3 | Eagle | WA-OWF | Rabe | | Conducting burn-out to secure indirect line; public and traffic remains a concern |
| 4 | Manastash Ridge (Conrad Lake) | WA-OWF | Nickey | | Continuing prep on primary and secondary control lines |
| 5 | Big Windy Complex | OR-MED | Wilder | | Assessing opportunities to go direct; received precipitation over fire area |
| 6 | Vinegar | OR-UMF | Fillis | | Contingency work completed; TOC expected 8/27 to T3 IMT |
| 7 | Douglas Complex | OR-DFPA (732) | Savage | | TOC expected 8/26 to T3 IMT |
