3	Mt. Adams Complex	WA-GPF	B. Gales	L1 evacuations on north end of complex; assessing new starts
4	Little Spokane	WA-NES	M. Ciraulo	70% contained; mop up continues; TOC back to local unit on 7/13
5	West Fork	OR-MAF	B. Fillis	Measurable precipitation and heavy demob; TOC back to the local unit 7/13
6	Corner Creek	OR-OCF	B. Fillis	70% contained; measurable precipitation and heavy demob; TOC back to local unit on 7/14
7	Paradise	WA-OLP	B. Hahnenberg	Confine/contain strategy; TOC back to local unit on 7/14
8	231	WA-NES	M. Ciraulo	100% contained; TOC back to local unit on 7/13
