### Strategic Intent:

1. Continue to emphasize public and firefighter safety while stabilizing incidents so that communities can return to normal activities.
2. Utilize resources efficiently so that we enhance initial attack response and capability to manage emerging and large incidents.

### PNW Incident Priorities (*set once per day*):

1	Initial Attack			Initial Attack always first priority.
2	Canyon Creek Complex	OR-MAF	B. Lund	Level 1 and 2 evacuations in place; southeast corner is problematic; TOC to IMT2 on 9/6.
3	North Star	WA-COA	E. Lewis	Level 1 and 2 evacuations in place; Highway 21 remains closed; Structure protection along Highway 21; Highway 155 has a partial closure.
4	Carpenter Road	WA-NES	D. Johnson	Level 1 evacuations in place; structure protection group remains in place; Springdale Hunter Road opened; Hunter's Campground and boat ramp opened.
5	Okanogan Complex	WA-NES	M. Minton	Level 1 evacuations in place; prepping for burnout.
6	Tunk Block	WA-NES	E. Lewis	Level 1 and 3 evacuations in place; some Level 3 evacuations reduced to Level 1; Highways 20 and 155 are closed to public; Structure protection in place.

7	Kettle Complex	WA-COF	C. Schulte	Level 1 and 2 evacuations in place; improving line in burnout areas.
8	Chelan Complex	WA-OWF	M. Minton	Level 1 evacuations in place.
9	Wolverine	WA-OWF	C. Templin	Level 1 evacuations in place; Minimal fire growth; Improving indirect and direct line.
10	Grizzly Bear Complex	OR-UMF	B. Gales	Level 1 and 2 evacuations in place; all evacuations scheduled to be lifted on 9/5; TOC to IMT3 on 9/6.
11	Cougar Creek	WA-YAA	M. Wakoski	Implementing direct strategy on the north flank.
12	Kaniksu Complex	WA-COF	T. Kurth	Grease Creek is the only fire of concern.
13	First Creek	WA-OWF	C. Templin	Level 1 evacuations in place; residents are returning to homes.
