Northwest Activity Summary

The region stayed cool and moist yesterday with relative humidity staying above 30% for even the driest locations. Moderate precipitation fell over western Washington and northwestern Oregon along with light precipitation further south and over the Blue Mountains. General winds were a little breezy east of the Cascades with gusts into the 20s. No lightning was observed. Large fires reported minimal fire behavior and no growth.

Rough Patch Complex. OR-UPF-000373. ICT4. 26 mi SE of Cottage Grove, OR. Start 7/29. **Full Suppression.** Cause: Unknown. 50,409 acres (+0). 74% containment. Minimal fire behavior. Timber. Road, trail and area closures.

Jack Fire. OR-UPF-000265. ICT4. 20 mi E of Glide, OR. Start 7/5. **Full Suppression.** Cause: Human. 24,165 acres (+0). 83% containment. Minimal fire behavior. Timber. Road, trail and area closures.

Devils Knob Complex. OR-UPF-000450. IMT3. 30 mi SE of Roseburg, OR. Start 8/3. **Full Suppression.** Cause: Lightning. 70,110 acres (+0). 65% containment. Minimal fire behavior. Timber. Road, trail and area closures. No new information.

Northwest Fire Weather Summary

Western Washington, northwestern Oregon, and higher elevations on the east side of the region will continue to see precipitation chances today into Saturday, while the rest of the region will be dry. General winds will be light today and tomorrow. Temperatures will warm into the weekend. A stronger front will move into the region Sunday, bringing more widespread precipitation as well as breezy winds and cooler temperatures. Early next week should see a break in the precipitation before another weather system approaches mid-week. See local NWS fire weather forecasts for details.
