**Date/Time Stamp:** Tuesday, Jun 27, 2017, 13:52

**Northwest Activity Summary**

Mild on the west side with very warm conditions on the east side with hot conditions in the Columbia Basin. Gusty winds on the east side with moderate overnight humidity recoveries. Significant lightning southeast of a line from Northwest Oregon to Northeast Washington with light scattered precipitation but heavy in isolated locations. High initial attack yesterday with 6 new large fires reported.

**Northwest Current Incident Details**

**Incidents not Previously Reported: 2**

**Gerber Flat** OR-LAD-000194. ICT4. 30 mi E of Klamath Falls, OR. Start 6/26. **Full Suppression.** Cause: Lightning. 250 acres. 0% containment. Timber, brush and short grass. Active fire behavior with wind driven runs and spotting. Cultural resources threatened.

**Horse Cross** OR-VAD-000053. ICT3. 15 mi W of Rome, OR. Start 6/26. **Full Suppression.** Cause: Lightning. 5,500 acres. 10% containment. Brush and short grass. Moderate fire behavior. Priority sage grouse habitat and special management areas threatened.

**Wenatchee Area Fires.** Includes: Spartan (4,397 ac), Kingsbury (30 ac), Southerlin Canyon (600 ac), Francis Canyon (300 ac), Wood (60 ac), Straight Hollow (1,400 ac). Type 3 Organization inbriefing. Structures threatened. Evacuation notices in effect. State Mobilization activated for Spartan Fire. Limited information available.

**Incidents Previously Reported: 2**

**Oak Springs 0326 RN** OR-PRD-000326. ICT3. 1 mi N of Maupin, OR. Start 6/24. **Full Suppression.** Cause: Human. 375 acres. 90% containment. Brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior. No structures threatened.

**Mecca Fire** OR-WSC-000001. Start 6/25. 2,413 acres. 0% Containment. Grass, brush and juniper. Minimal fire behavior. No structures threatened.

**Northwest Fire Potential Summary**

Moderating weather over the next couple days with normal temperatures and reasonable humidity recoveries. The potential for precipitation is minimal. Winds should be moderate over the forecast period. The potential for holdover fires is likely over the next few days. A slight warming trend builds up later in the week with cooler temps returning over the weekend to moderate conditions again.
