Northwest Activity Summary

An early spring week of cloudy and cool conditions occurred over the Region. Precipitation coverage west of the Cascades was thorough. East of the Cascades moderate to light coverage at the upper elevations was widespread. Lower elevation basins received light to moderate coverage. Prescribed fire activity noted in agricultural areas in Central Washington. Initial attack activity remains light.
