** IA HANDCREW MODULE = Handcrew or Squad. 20 person IA Crew = 4 IA MODULES.

*** Once IC determines the fire is human caused, FINV will be assigned by duty officer regardless of staffing level.

Resources listed under “consider” will function as prompts for the DO, IC and Dispatch.
