Complex fires

For fires where perimeters have burnt together and each incident cannot be identified on the ground, fill only one out for the total acreage, and damages. For those fires that have distinct and separate perimeters, each individual fire needs a daily update. Even if there is one team managing the complex of fires.

Damages:

Enter damages and threats for Residences and Other Structures. For **Residences and Other Structures** use "each" as the unit of measure. These are listed as 1) threatened inside perimeter and 2) damaged/destroyed inside perimeter. Damaged/Destroyed is ONLY counted once. It is not your responsibility to determine extent of damage.
