APPLICATION PERIODS

Incident Commanders, Deputy Incident Commanders, and Incident Commander Trainees November 3 to November 24, 2023

All Interested Applicants December 8, 2023 to January 19, 2024

The California Wildland Fire Coordinating Group (CWCG) is seeking interested, qualified and highly motivated applications from all persons in all agencies to fill positions on all California Interagency Incident Management Teams.

- The application period for consideration as an Incident Commander, Deputy Incident Commander or trainee position is **November 3 November 24, 2023.**
- The application period for **ALL** qualified, trainee and apprentice positions on a California Interagency Incident Management Teams is **December 8, 2023 January 19, 2024.**
- Interested candidates will apply for a 3-year term.
- Teams will be comprised of 35 Core Team members (subject to change)
- Federal Employee applicants are expected to apply for Complex Incident Management positions.
- Local Government applicants are expected to apply for qualified Type 1 and Type 2 positions.
- Microsoft Forms will be utilized when applying for an IMT.

As a member of a California Interagency Incident Management Team (CIIMT), team members will find themselves in an atmosphere of complex incidents. This provides opportunity and experience in unique team-oriented decision-making situations, as well as development of personal and professional accomplishment. CIIMT team members are expected to demonstrate the highest level of performance in their positions and in their professional demeanor.

CIIMT members will be selected by the incident commanders collaborating with CWCG operations committee will select the CIIMT members after the application period closes January 19, 2024.

Applicants will commit to a three-year term and will only need to apply annually should they choose to apply to a new team and/or qualified position. Applicants are encouraged to apply for a specific team but may be asked to serve on another team based on vacancies and other needs. Selected candidates will fill the position for 3 years. IMT assignments are normally 14 days plus travel.

- National Wildfire Coordinating Group (NWCG) Wildland Fire Qualifications Guide 310-1
- Forest Service Fire and Aviation Qualifications Guide (January 2023)
- California Incident Command Certifications System (CICCS), or
- California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection 4039.

A copy of your most current Incident Qualification Card must be provided for Federal applicants. Cooperators not utilizing the CICCS or Incident Qualifications and Certification System must include a letter from their Unit Fire Chief certifying their qualification for the position. Forest Service employees must obtain approval through their Forest Supervisor.
