The California Wildland Fire Coordinating Group (CWCG) is seeking interested, qualified and highly motivated applications from all persons in all agencies to fill positions on all California Interagency Incident Management Teams.

- The application period for consideration as an Incident Commander, Deputy Incident Commander or trainee position is **October 15 November 10, 2025**.
- The application period for ALL qualified and trainee positions on California Interagency Incident Management Teams is December 1, 2025 to January 12, 2026
- Federal Employee applicants are expected to apply for Complex Incident Management positions.
- Local Government applicants are expected to apply for qualified Type 1 and Type 2 positions.
- Microsoft Forms will be utilized when applying for an IMT.

As a member of a California Interagency Incident Management Team (CIIMT), team members will find themselves in an atmosphere of complex incidents. This provides opportunities and experience in unique team-oriented decision-making situations, as well as development of personal and professional accomplishment. CIIMT team members are expected to demonstrate the highest level of performance in their positions and in their professional demeanor.

Applicants are encouraged to apply for a specific team but may be asked to serve on another team based on vacancies and other needs. IMT assignments are normally 14 days plus travel.

All applicants must meet qualification requirements using the current version of one of the following:

- National Wildfire Coordinating Group (NWCG) Wildland Fire Qualifications Guide PMS 310-1
- Forest Service Fire & Aviation Qualification Guide
- California Incident Command Certifications System (CICCS)
- California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection 4039.

A copy of your most current Incident Qualification Card must be provided for Federal applicants. Cooperators not utilizing the CICCS or Incident Qualifications and Certification System must include a letter from their Unit Fire Chief certifying their qualification for the position. Forest Service employees must obtain written approval through their Forest Fire Chief or designee.
