As a member of a California Interagency Incident Management Team (CIIMT), team members will find themselves actively engaged in a very demanding and challenging work environment. These opportunities provide professionals with valuable experience working with other highly motivated individuals in a dynamic team-oriented atmosphere. CIIMT personnel are expected to demonstrate the highest level of performance in their positions and in their professional demeanor. IMT assignments are usually 14 days in length with additional days to accommodate for travel to and from an incident.

CIIMT members will be selected by the Incident Commanders, and their draft rosters will be approved by the CWCG Operations Sub-Committee.

- California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection 4039.

A copy of your most current Incident Qualification Card must be provided for Federal applicants. Cooperators not utilizing the CICCS or Incident Qualifications and Certification System must include a letter from their Unit Fire Chief certifying their qualification for the position. A copy of your most current Incident Qualification Card may be requested.
