Title: RMA Incident Commander Trainee process for mobilization

Issue: IMT2 Trainees have been prioritized for the 2012 season without clarification of the process for rostering trainees and the process for collection and documentation of evaluations.

Background/Status: For the 2012 season, ICT2 trainees will utilize a rotation process to give trainees (in order of priority) the largest opportunity for assignments. It was brought to the attention of the Operations committee, that the process for rostering an IC trainee was unclear.

Recommendation(s): We the Operations Committee recommend the following to RMCG for consideration:

1. When the Incident Commander, or designee, is compiling an on-call roster, the Incident Commander will contact the Type II IC trainees in order of priority until one has been determined to be available. The Incident Commander will roster the trainee, and that trainee will remain available for the entire “on-call” period of that rotation. It is the responsibility of the trainee to make their status known to Incident Commanders.
2. At the completion of a trainee assignment, the trainee will provide their RMCG Operations Committee representative a copy of their assignment evaluation. The agency representative will forward a copy to the chair of the Operations Committee.
**This will include the Type I Incident Commander Trainee.
3. The RMA Type II Incident Commanders will include the top five trainees on their mailing lists to provide continuity of communication.

The Operations Committee remains dedicated to supporting identified trainees through the RMCC for trainee assignments throughout the year, to ensure succession for leadership on our teams.
