

2.7 28 29 All Juniper Valley crews are sponsored by the Colorado State Department of Correction. They can respond anywhere in the RMA and adjacent GACCs if within 1 day's drive of Colorado. They can be self-sufficient if necessary but work best in a fire camp situation. When two of the three have been assigned, the availability of the third will be negotiated. Note: If the Juniper Valley – Rifle crew is being deployed as a suppression module, they should be ordered in ROSS as Overhead, Module, Suppression.

All Smokebuster crews are sponsored by the Wyoming State Department of Corrections and can only be used in WY and SD-BKF. If they are deployed in 7 person squads, they should be ordered in ROSS as Overhead, Module, Suppression.

The DFPC Crew 11 is a State of Colorado crew comprised of DFPC and cooperating agency personnel. This crew may also be augmented with members from the BLM's Team Rubicon. Within Colorado, this crew is configured as a 5 person squad with a T4 engine.
