

Type 3 Team Logistics Kit and Rules of Thumb

Suggested Items for a Type 3 Logistics (Enhanced BCMG) Kit:

- Cody Dispatch Center Field Operations Guide
- Cody Dispatch Type 3 team logistics checklist (see Team Operating Guideline document)
- Copy of BLM and SHF Command Trailers inventory and set-up instructions
- CDC Fire Business Guidelines and Interagency Fire Business Mgmt Handbook and Red Book
- Ft. Washakie 100 person cache van inventory, Spike Camp supply list
- Phone books that cover the dispatch zone
- Fire phone contact list – either CDC Mob Guide Ch. 50 copy or other source
- Road atlas, Forest and BLM maps
- Crew Time Reports, Equipment Shift Tickets, Red Dogs, General Message Forms, Vehicle/Equipment Inspection Checklist, Resource Order – Supply forms, Equipment Use Invoice
- NFES Catalog – Part 1. Basecamp Manager Job Aid, J-254 from NWCG website IRPG
- Notepad, Pencils, Pens, Fat Markers, Item Tags, Calculator, Digital Camera, Cell Phone, Flashlight/headlamp, Handheld Radio and Clamshell
- 1 or 2 Flats AA Batteries, Trash Bags, several rolls TP, Duct Tape, Fiber Tape, Few rolls flagging, hand sanitizer, several rolls TP.
- Personal Gear and Food/Water for several days for self and overhead (Cubies/MREs)

Clay's Rules of Thumb on Ordering

- Think 2 days out on any ordering – get enough but not too much (timber vs grass fire). Confirm with plans/IC on meal arrangements/times etc.
- MREs – 12 per box, 48 boxes per pallet. 20 person crew = 6 boxes per day. Get allowable supplemental food items (fruit, health bars, etc).
- Water – 1 cubie = 5 gal. 20 person crew = 8 to 10 cubies per day depending on heat factor. If ordering bottled water, consider using 1 or 2 gallon jugs to reduce waste for filling canteens. Some bottled water good for coolers to encourage hydration.
- AA Batteries - one package (PG) = 24 batts, 1 case/flat = 8 PG. 1 PG per radio for 2 days. 20 person crew = 1 case/flat per day.
- Attempt recycling cardboard, plastic, batteries with local unit
- Coolers, Ice, and Sports Drinks – enough to put around at staging/camp, helibase, etc.
- Porta Potties – 1 blue hotel per 8-10 folks. 1 handwash station per 2 or 3 hotels. Camp, helibase typical locations. Specify cleaning once per day.
- Refer to Spike Camp supply list.
- Order Sat Phones if communications issues with spike or other camp.
- Check with Resource Advisor on any camp location issues (weeds, archy, etc)
- Assess camp traffic pattern, sleeping locations, and safety and sign accordingly with SOFR
- Garbage needs (service vs. trash cans) and food storage vs. bears
- If contracted equipment, get equipment inspector/manager
