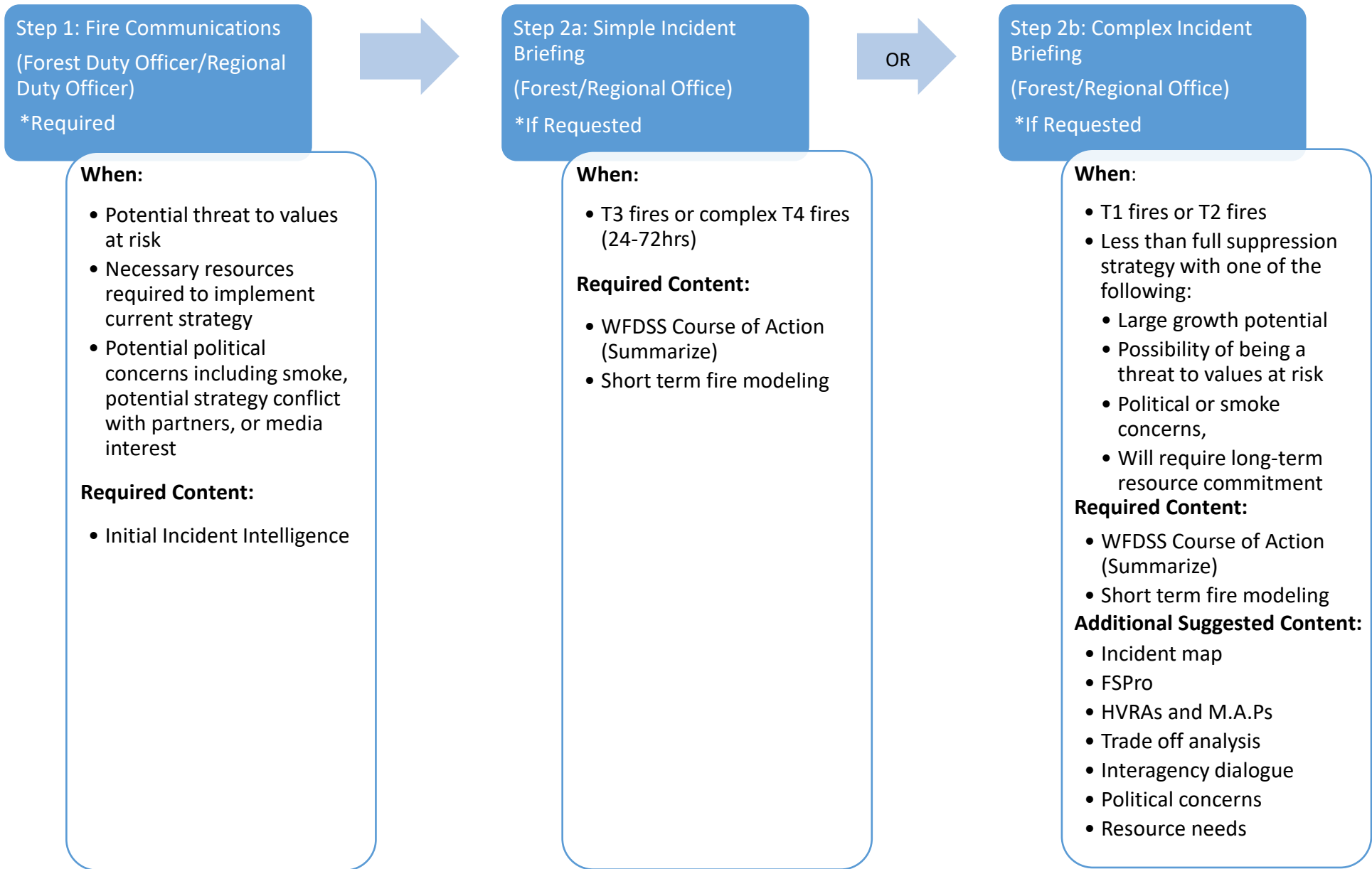


# Communication Flow Chart

Anticipated resource commitment <small>(regional/national resources)</small>	
Critical decision points <small>(trigger points/transitions/change in strategy)</small>	
Projected cost	

ENGAGEMENT WITH PARTNER AGENCIES AND STAKEHOLDERS	
Pre-season risk-sharing dialogue completed (Y/N)	
Interagency dialogue specific to this incident: <small>Strategy Support, Concerns, Joint Communications, Cost-share, Smoke, other</small>	
How have you prepared the public for what to expect? <small>Closures, Smoke, Duration, Other</small>
