Hardluck fire

The 2013 fire season turned out to be below average year for fires and slightly above for acres burned. The first wildfire of the season occurred at the end of March with the final fire of the year occurring mid-September. Total number of fires, all agencies this season was 167, of those 103 were human caused and 64 lightning. Total acres all agencies was 29767. The 5 year average for number of fires and acres is 196 fires for 26747 acres for all agencies with in the Cody Interagency Dispatch Center area.

The dispatch center supported several extended attack fires, including 2 Type 3 incidents and 1 Type 2 incident (Fairfield). The Hardluck fire on the Shoshone was a long duration event and rotated several Type 3 ICs through the 2 month long fire.

The Cody Interagency Dispatch center began mobilizing resources in early May. The dispatch center mobilized equipment, crews, aircraft, overhead and supplies totaling 1871 resource orders processed in support of local incidents as well as incidents in Wyoming, California, Colorado, Montana, New Mexico, Idaho, North Dakota, Alaska, Washington, Nevada, Oregon and Utah. Expanded Dispatch was in place for 48 days starting in July.

The Dispatch Center was fully staffed with the BIA position being filled by an Engine Module Leader from the Shoshone National Forest for a 6 month time period. Two FS seasonal dispatchers were also hired and there were two "broken" firefighters in dispatch for most of the season which proved to be very advantageous to both the center and the employees. 527 Incident Actions were processed this past year which included wildfire appropriate management responses, prescribed fire support, public assists, all risk incidents, flight requests/following for: the USFS Regional Bug flight, USFWS Grizzly Bear Survey, USFWS Elk & Sheep Survey, USGS Stream Gauge Inventory, USGS Elk Survey, Wind River Grizzly Survey, Wind River Elk Survey, and locally for Whitebark Pine Survey, several Wildhorse flights, Wilderness, Radio Repeater Maintenance, and Sage Grouse programs.

On the Horizon, the dispatch center staff continues to represent and support the dispatch community at the area and national level with personnel involved in training, ROSS Reports Management Board, WildCAD, National Dispatch Training Steering committee, D-510 Steering committee, and assisting centers across the board with reports, web pages, and computer programs.











5 - Year Averages: Fires and Acres





Resource Order Requests Processed
