## CODY INTERAGENCY DISPATCH CENTER 2010 YEAR END REPORT

The 2010 fire season was an average year; the normal weather patterns that occurred were typical for this area. The first wildfire of the season occurred the first part of February with the final fire of the year occurring mid November. Total number of fires, all agencies this season was 168 for 2220 acres.

The dispatch center supported several extended attack fires, including 2 type 3 incidents. In addition, the center mobilized equipment, crews, aircraft, supplies, and overhead totaling 1264 resource orders processed. Expanded Dispatch was in place for 12 days mainly in support of the North Fork fire.

The Dispatch Center functioned with one permanent position unfilled until September when the vacant IA Dispatcher/Zone Training position was filled. The BIA IA dispatch position was filled in late spring and 2 seasonal dispatchers started in April and worked into October. Several "broken" fire fighters assisted in dispatch, one for the entire season and 2 Hotshots, each for a couple of months.

550 Incident Actions were processed this past year which included wildfire appropriate management responses, prescribed fire support, all risk incidents, flight following for the regional bug flight, public assists, and flight requests in support of the wildhorse, wilderness, radio maintenance, and sage grouse programs.




### Fire Statistics by Unit

## Fire Acres by Cause and Agency











## 2010 Aircraft Summary

The dispatch area had 6 T1 helicopters on 5 incidents, 2 T2 helicopters on 2 incidents, 18 T3 helicopters on 15 incidents, 5 SEATs on 5 incidents, 1 T2 air tanker on 1 incident, 2 Lead Planes on 2 incidents, and 6 ATGS platforms on 4 incidents.\*
