

COOL AND BREEZY TODAY IN THE WAKE OF A COLD FRONT. WESTERLY WINDS WILL PICK UP THIS MORNING AT A STEADY 20 TO 35 MPH ACROSS THE DISPATCH AREA. MINIMUM RHS WILL BE MAINLY IN THE 20S WITH A FEW TEENS POSSIBLE IN 289. A WARMING AND DRYING TREND BEGINS ON MONDAY WITH A FEW SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS POSSIBLE ON MONDAY AFTERNOON...MAINLY OVER THE HIGHER ELEVATIONS AND WITH A LOW CHANCE OF WETTING RAIN. THERE WILL BE A BETTER CHANCE OF THUNDERSTORMS ON TUESDAY AS THE AIR BECOMES HOTTER AND MORE UNSTABLE. THE LOWER LEVELS SHOULD BE FAIRLY DRY WITH MINIMUM RHS EXPECTED TO BE IN THE LOW TEENS...SO MANY OF THE STORMS WILL BE DRY AND COULD PRODUCE STRONG OUTFLOW WINDS...ESPECIALLY OVER 280 281 AND 300.
