

HIGH PRESSURE DOMINATES THE WEATHER THIS WEEKEND WITH COOL TEMPERATURES AT NIGHT AND WARM TEMPERATURES DURING THE DAY. A GENERALLY CLEAR SKY CAN BE EXPECTED OVER THE DISTRICT WITH AN INCREASE IN SOUTHWESTERLY BREEZES SUNDAY AFTERNOON AND EVENING LEADING TO THE POTENTIAL FOR A CRITICAL FIRE WEATHER DAY ACROSS ZONES 280...289 AND 300. ISOLATED THUNDERSTORMS ARE POSSIBLE LATER MONDAY AND MONDAY NIGHT AS A COLD FRONT MOVES TOWARD THE AREA.
